

Alternative Models of Religious Education 2020-21

We hope to offer more than convenience with these new models. We aim to provide something that will add to the life of your family without adding stress.

Please note - Sunday family PREP sessions one parent and all PREP children in the family. Both parents are encouraged to attend and younger children are welcome.

To register all past due balances must be fully met, one parent must have attended a Parent Information Session on the new models and children must have good current PREP attendance or legitimate reason why attendance has not been good.

Two Options

Summer PREP

This is a one week intensive program meant to not only teach the faith but help pass on a strong Catholic identity through daily Mass, experience of prayer, studying the Saints and more. Participation in 5 family PREP Sundays will assist parents in bringing their faith into their home while giving the kids a refresher on what they learned in the summer. It also gives families a chance to share faith with each other.

Requirements

One week of catechist led instruction June 22-26 (7:50/8:00-2:30)
Attendance on all 5 days for the full day is required.

5 Sunday Family PREP Days (9 offered, choose 5)

Completion of home assignments

Same as Final assessment given during weekly PREP. Will be due in September.

Parish Involvement

Weekly Mass Attendance, Reconciliation at least 1x a year

Family PREP

This program centers faith formation in the home because families are considered the Domestic Church. Two monthly lessons are completed at home as a family after parents first get an update on the topic on the Sunday PREP day. We equip parents with the tools to bring faith into their homes and teach their

children about their faith. Giving them the ability to have faith touch all aspects of their families lives.

Requirements

1 Sunday a month 9AM-11:00AM. Mass attendance required before or after session.

2 lessons a month led by parent at home

Completion of home assignments

Same as Mid year and Final assessment given during weekly PREP.
One will be due in February the other in May.

Weekly Mass Attendance, Reconciliation at least 1x a year

Sacrament Years

All Sacrament levels have an extra book as part of the curriculum.

Projects for Confirmation

Attendance required at parent meetings, rehearsals, refresher classes, retreats
(extra monthly at home lesson for family PREP)
