REFLECTION

Over the next two weeks we will hear an extended passage from Matthew's Gospel in which Jesus reinterprets the law for his disciples. He challenges his disciples to take it one step further, to do more than just follow the letter of the law. On this Presidents' Day weekend, when we honor those people whom we have trusted to guide our country, let us consider how we can trust Jesus to guide us in our daily life.

In the first reading, Sirach teaches us that we have the ability to choose between right and wrong. Choosing to trust in God and to keep the commandments is the way to salvation. Jesus extends the commandments when speaking to his disciples, telling them that they must do more. May the Holy Spirit, invoked by Paul in the second reading, reveal God's wisdom and guide us in our behavior.
