Most Holy Trinity

REFLECTION

Today we honor the Holy Trinity – one God, yet three Persons. God is one, but God is not alone. God is love and in the Trinity we have an ideal example of a relationship of pure and infinite love. Every time we make the sign of the cross may we be reminded of the love that bonds the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. May the love of the Holy Trinity be a model for us in our relationships with each other.

Don't let your mind wander during the readings today! Each of them is very short, so if you're not paying attention you might miss an entire one. You wouldn't want to do that, for in each case a lot is packed into just a few verses. God reveals the holy name in the first reading, Paul sums up his message to the Corinthians in the second. In the Gospel, John synthesizes Jesus' entire mission in three short verses. Let us listen as if each author is speaking directly to us.

Message from Fr. John:

We are happy to resume Mass at Our Lady's Church. While we are only able to celebrate one Sunday Mass at this time and attendance will be limited, please remember the dispensation from the Sunday and holy day obligation will remain in effect. At this time weekday Masses are still suspended until further notice. As changes are made to the Mass schedule and the sign-up procedure, we will communicate that on our website and through email. If you are a registered parishioner, but not receiving an email, please let us know. If you would like to register as a parishioner, please register online or download a registration form and send it to our parish office.

Please keep in mind these important guidelines when visiting the church:

- A face mask is required.
- Sanitize your hands.
- Social distancing is required.
- Enter the church through the front door unless you require handicap access.
- Exit through all doors.
- Church seating will be limited - pews are marked so family/individuals will sit 3 pews apart.
- There will be no offertory collection, but we will have a donation receptacle as you enter the church.
- Missalettes and paper aids in the pews are removed.
- There will be no exchange of the sign of peace and no holy water in the fonts.
- Minimize the use of the restrooms if possible.

Thank you for your patience as we work through our plans for re-opening. Please continue to pray for our church community that we remain faithful to our Lord.
