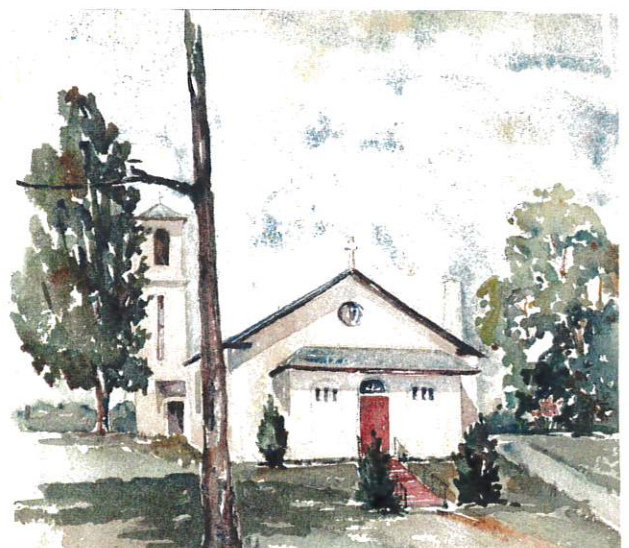

REFLECTION

Announcement from the Archdiocese of Washington

The dispensation from obligation to attend Mass is lifted beginning June 26 and 27. Catholics are encouraged to return to public Mass. This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus, or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions.

Message from Fr. John

Please note the following procedures we are following at our parish:

† The use of masks while gathered indoors is not required for fully vaccinated individuals and is recommended for non-vaccinated individuals. If you're fully vaccinated, you may continue to wear masks, particularly if you have an underlying health condition. The priests and other ministers of communion are still required to wear masks when we distribute the Body of Christ.

† Social distancing is still required between individuals from separate households for indoor gatherings; however, the requirements are relaxed. We are now opening all the pews on the St. Joseph side of the church. The Blessed Mother side will remain as every other pew for those who are still not comfortable being too close physically to non-family members. We ask that everyone who sits on this side please wear a mask.

† During the sign of peace, we may continue what we have been doing (waving, smiling, nodding) but shaking other people's hands is still not allowed.

† Beginning June 5 we will start collecting Offertory with the baskets again, but the Ushers will be required to wear masks.

Thank you for your continued patience as we work through our new routines.

Call the Rectory: Please keep Fr. John or the Parish Office informed if someone is sick or hospitalized. We can add their name to the prayer list. They can also have a visit from Fr. John.

MASS INTENTION REQUESTS

You may request a Mass for a loved one by recording their name in the Mass Intention Book on the table near the Sacred Heart Statue in the church. Just select a date from the monthly list of dates, then complete one of the Mass Intention envelopes and include your stipend. **Put the envelope in the Collection basket.** The usual stipend is \$10. If this is a financial hardship for you, just give what you can or simply make the request. Mass cards signed by Fr. John are also available. Please contact the rectory if you need assistance.

Our plan for this upcoming CCD instruction was to offer it mostly online with limited in classroom instruction. If we cannot find a qualified candidate, St. Aloysius has graciously offered to educate our children there. St. Aloysius' program is also mostly online, using the same program we use - *My Catholic Faith Delivered* - with limited in-class instruction as well, but the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation would be celebrated at Our Lady's Church.
