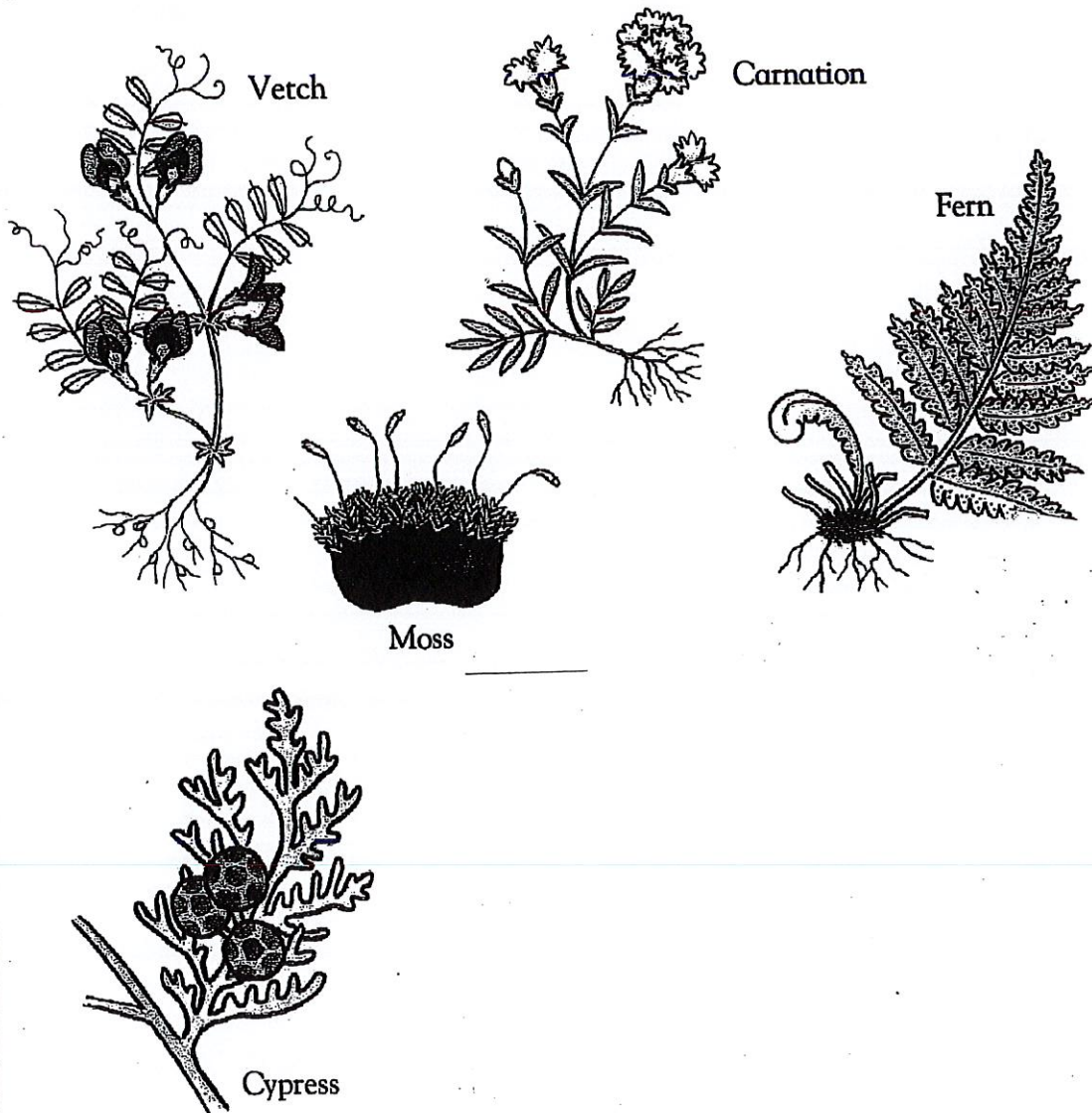
Flower power

Background knowledge

Most plants produce *seeds* that grow into new plants. All seeds contain a baby plant, stored food, and a protective covering. The seeds of conifer trees grow into woody cones. The seeds of other plants grow inside flowers. Ferns and mosses have neither cones nor flowers. Instead, they have special parts that produce *spores*. The spore cases appear as small specks on the underside of the plant's leaves. Each spore can grow into a new plant.

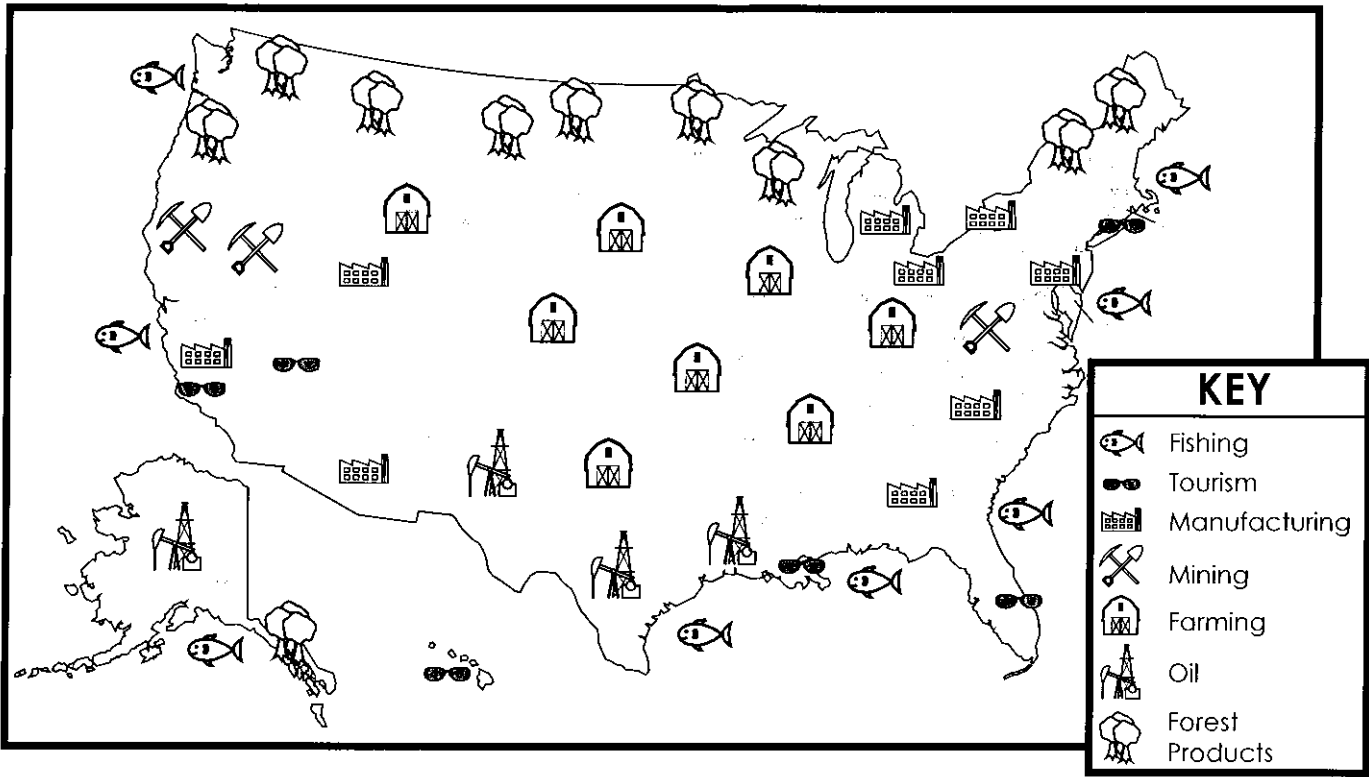
