Principal's Report (Patrick Tiernan)	 Thank you to the HSA Board for their support. My vision is to make SMM a model of Catholic grade school excellence. Three Important Values: (1) Organizational Culture. Focus on professional development (workshop in October); improving supervision and evaluation model; visible curriculum with Google classroom. (2) Communication Processes. One big issue in parent survey was communication. Friday newsletter has great information in it. We are
