"Set within each of our hearts is the desire for life as it was meant to be... We must journey to find the life we prize. And the guide we have been given is the desire set deep within, the desire we often overlook or mistake for something else or even choose to ignore. The greatest human tragedy is to give up the search." (John Eldredge, *The Journey of Desire*). In Sunday's Gospel, we see, both, the reward and danger of allowing our deepest desires to shine. Simeon and Anna persevered in their journey to meet Christ and were rewarded with incredible joy. We also see that Mary suffered her first of seven sorrows as Simeon warns that she will be pierced with the sword of evil. We will suffer many disappointments and eventually be led to Jesus and the joy of the Resurrection. THAT IS Christianity.

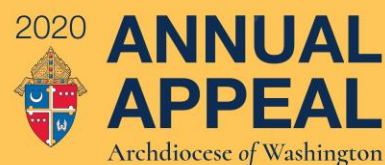
