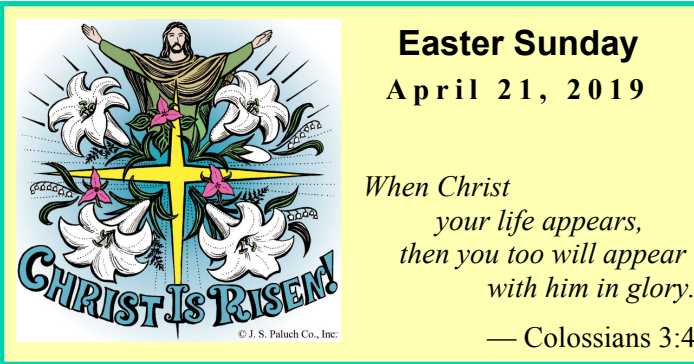

**Incarnation’s St. Vincent de Paul Society**

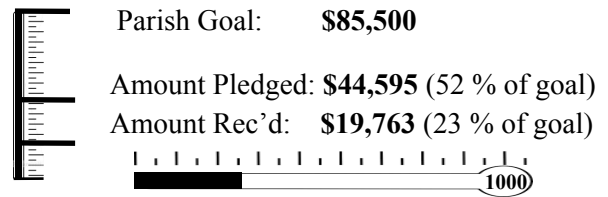

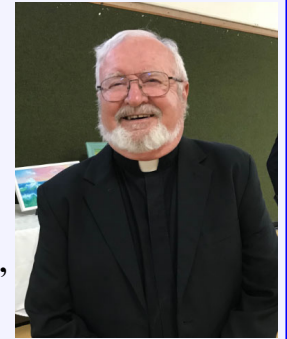
