OUR LOAN IS FINALLY PAID OFF!**

For the past 13 years, our parish has been working very hard to pay off a \$3.15M loan from the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, which we took out in 2006 in order to purchase the property on Central Avenue where our Incarnation Community Center sits. This loan supplemented the \$3.6M which had already been raised in the capital campaign that was initiated in 2001. Last week, we made our final loan payment. Thanks to your persistent generosity, **OUR PARISH IS NOW DEBT FREE!** This is a tremendous accomplishment, and certainly cause to celebrate! **This Sunday, May 5, after all of the morning Masses, we will have a mortgage burning ceremony on the patio, along with refreshments, to celebrate this outstanding moment in our parish's history.**
