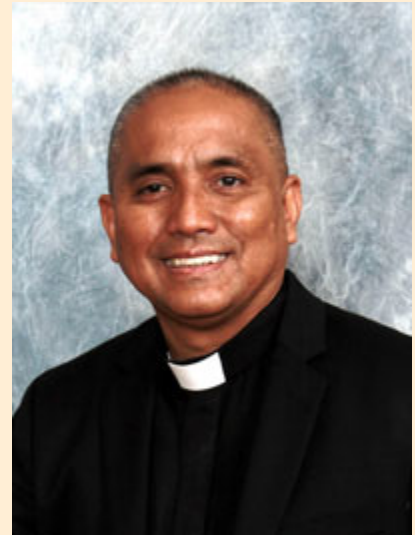

We have received official notification that Fr. Rodel Balagtas has been appointed by Archbishop Gomez as the new pastor of Incarnation Parish, effective July 1, 2019.

Fr. Rodel, who was ordained a priest in 1991, is finishing his five-year assignment at St. John's Seminary in Camarillo, where he has served as Director of Pastoral Formation, Vice Rector and Assistant Professor in the field of ministerial studies. Before his seminary assignment, he served as pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Los Angeles for twelve years.

Fr. Rodel is delighted and excited to be our new pastor. He thanks Archbishop Gomez and the Personnel Board for their confidence in assigning him to be our spiritual leader.
