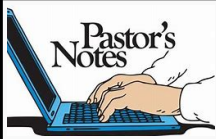

1st Reading: Genesis, 18:1-10a

GOD IN OUR MIDST

A delightful story on Abraham's life unfolds before us this Sunday as we listen to the First Reading.

Abraham was sitting on a hot day when he found three strangers standing nearby on the path. He ran to greet them and offered them hospitality. He provided them with a bucket of water to bathe their feet, shade to rest, and sumptuous food to refresh themselves.

The Reading later tells us that the presence of the three men was God mysteriously acting in the life of Abraham. After they rested and ate, one of them said to Abraham, "I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah will have a son."

As I reflected on this simple but touching story, I couldn't help but think of God's mysterious presence and actions in our life as a community here at Incarnation Church. At times without being aware of it, God indeed manifests himself to us in ordinary ways. It can be through the sincere handshake and smile of an usher in church, the home visit of a minister to the sick, the thoughtful phone call of a fellow choir member, or the caring counsel of one of our priests. With open hearts and spiritual eyes, we could sense the profound ways that God interacts with us.

This week, look around and feel God's presence in your life and our community here at Incarnation Church. Welcome Him and let yourself rest in His presence.

Young Disciples of Incarnation Catholic Church

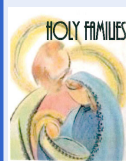
