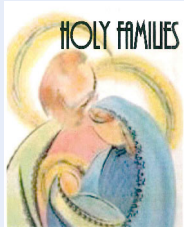

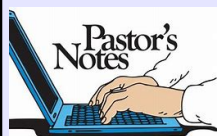

“You were buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead.” (Col 2:12)

You might not remember the date of your baptism, but it is one of the most important days of your life. For on that day, you were born again; you received new life in Jesus Christ through the water of baptism and the Holy Spirit.

Baptism washed away your original sin and infused your soul with sanctifying grace. It left an indelible spiritual mark (character) of belonging to Christ in your soul.
