### Take and Receive

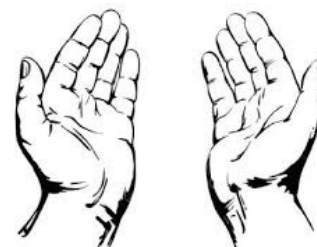
Take Lord, and receive
