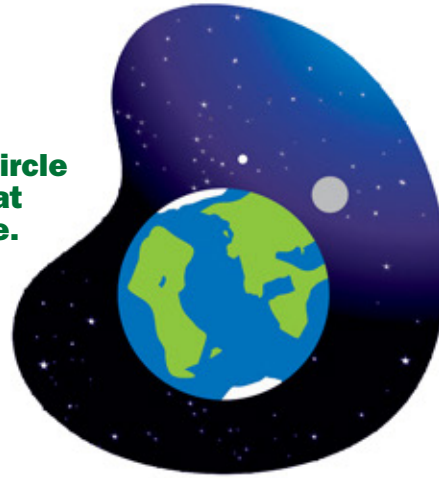


Who is God?

Our God is three Persons in one:

Father God
Son Jesus
Holy Spirit

Today is Trinity Sunday, the day we celebrate that in some mysterious way our loving God is three Persons in one: God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

For preschoolers and kindergartners we choose activities built around the number three and around familiar names for God, rather than struggling to teach complex trinitarian doctrine.

One thing you can do at home to help familiarize your child with the Trinity is to teach this traditional trinitarian prayer. Use the version used in your church's worship:

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be. Amen.
