MARCH 15: ST. ZECHARIAH

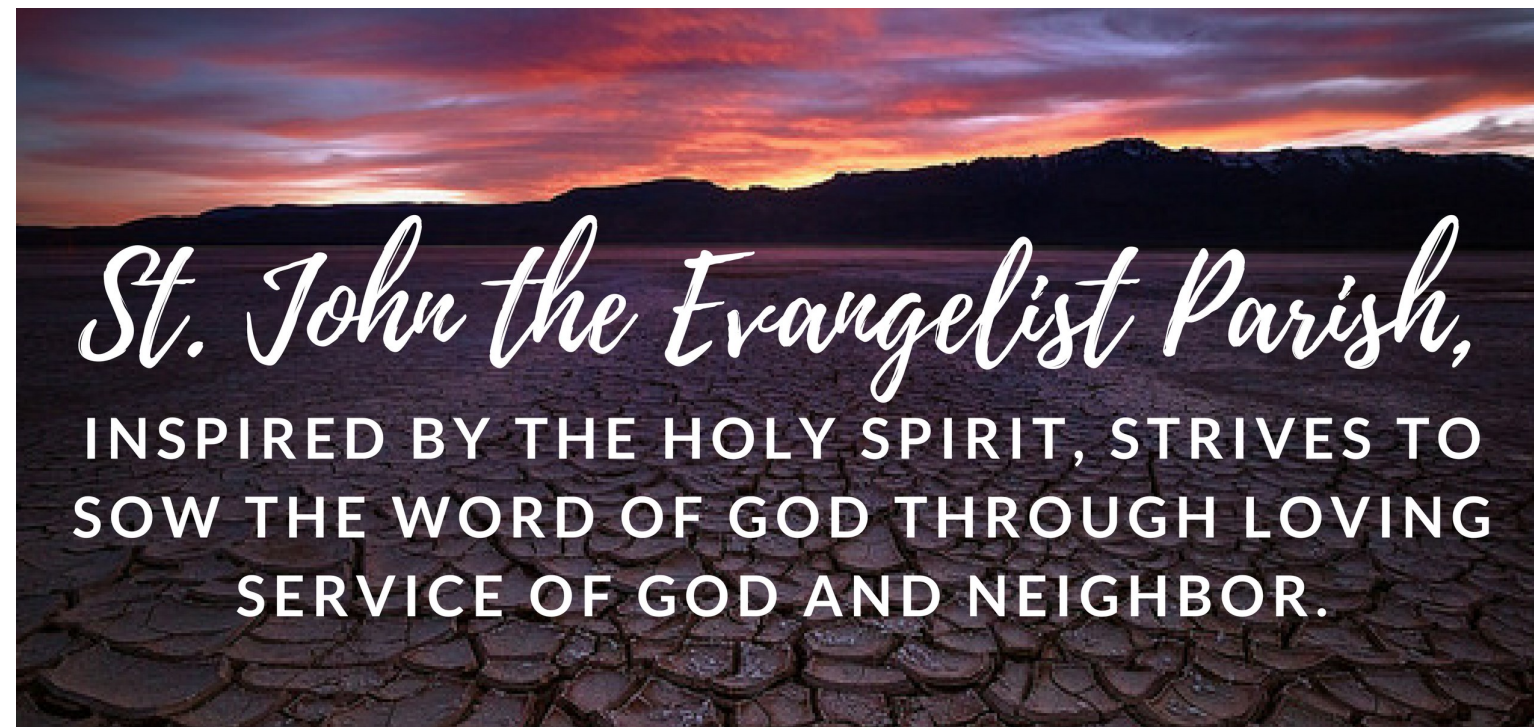

We pray that the Church in China may persevere in its faithfulness to the Gospel and grow in unity.

THE WOMAN AT THE WELL...

... is one of the more recognizable figures in the New Testament. Due to her "loose morals," she is a bit of a social outcast. In spite of this (or more likely, because of this), Jesus chooses to evangelize this woman. Let us learn from His method. He sits by the well, weary from the heat and from His travels. He strikes up a friendly conversation with a stranger, who also happens to be a woman and a Samaritan. He gains her trust, and when the time is right, Jesus suggests that perhaps her life is lacking truth and depth. He offers her mercy and salvation, and plants seeds of conversion in her heart. As missionary disciples, we should imitate this example as we carry out our work. We have not been asked to surround ourselves with those who are already on the path to holiness. No, we have been called to humble ourselves and to reach out to the undesirables. We should dine with sinners and tax collectors, and we should count ourselves among them. We should seek those who are lost, gain their trust, and draw them in with messages of mercy, hope, and salvation. This is the spirit of Lent, which we have been called to share.

PARISH LENTEN CROSS

Sin. We all do, after all. We are human. We're not perfect by any stretch of the imagination. However, oftentimes it becomes habit and we regard sin like we have a "Get Out of Jail Free" card as long as we go to Confession. How often do we stop to think about what our sin looks like? The effect that it has on us? On others? What would that look like if we could see it?

This Lent we have an opportunity to visualize our sin. Beginning Ash Wednesday, there will be a large cross on the church lawn. Each person will have the opportunity when they are ready to hammer a nail into the cross representing their sins. This cross will serve as a visual reminder that it is our sin that nails Christ to the Cross each day.

When we gaze upon Christ on the Cross, what do we see? 3 Nails and 4 Wounds? Or do we see the hundreds of nails put there each day by our sin, piercing every part of his body? Lent allows us the time to deepen our relationship with Christ, to once again turn away from our sinful habits and strengthen our resistance to sin.

This Lent as we work towards the conversion of our hearts and unity with Christ let's remember to pray for each other. We each put nails in the cross, so let's pray that we might show true remorse for our own sin and show each other the mercy God gives each of us.
