**NOVEMBER 8: BLESSED ELIZABETH OF THE TRINITY**



Elizabeth was born into a military family and was the oldest child. Her father was a captain and died when Elizabeth was 7 years old. She had a very bad temper...until her First Communion. This brought her closer to Jesus and helped her control herself. As she grew, her love for Jesus grew and she wanted to join the Carmelite convent. Her mother did not want her to go; she wanted her to marry. Elizabeth said no and joined the convent when she was 21 years old. She didn't live a very long life, she was only 26 when she died, but she wrote down many things about God to help us get closer to Him, too. She tells us we should hold on to God by loving Him and let God speak to us by being quiet and listening for His voice. She loved the mystery of God in the Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - and would spend a lot of time praying to God in His three person. One simple prayer that she left for us to say too is, "Holy Trinity Whom I Adore".

**PLenary INDULGENCE EXTENDED THROUGH MONTH OF NOVEMBER**

Due to the coronavirus and the need to avoid large groups, the Plenary Indulgence applicable to the deceased by those who visit a cemetery has been extended. This year, the indulgence can be obtained by anyone who visits a cemetery, even if only mentally, on any day in November, and devoutly prays for the faithful departed.

**The traditional conditions to attain a Plenary Indulgence:**

A Plenary Indulgence can be gained only once per day. The faithful must be in the state of grace and these three conditions must accompany the prescribed act:

1. The faithful must receive the sacrament of confession, within several days (about 20 days) before or after the pious act is performed
2. Receive Holy Communion on that day
3. Recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is the minimum, but additional prayers may be added).
4. All attachment to sin, even venial sin, must be absent. If one's disposition is less than perfect or if some of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence becomes a partial indulgence.

The parish Building Committee met on October 26th to review all feedback received from the town halls, including comments made at each town hall, and feedback forms received in writing or on our parish website. Many commented that they were pleased with the look of the new church and offices from the full-color architectural drawings. Several questions and suggestions were also offered about the interior layout of the church. Suggestions made included adding a cry room, making the seating capacity larger, and having transept seating (where the adoration chapel or choir is located in the current rendering). A question was presented asking if we needed a separate adoration chapel or if it could double as a cry room. These are all issues the committee is continuing to review and look at different options of how to configure the church that meets most requests.
