APRIL 25 : ST. MARK THE EVANGELIST

Mark lived in the time of Jesus but it is unclear if he had actually met Jesus. Some people believe that he had. Mark knew both St. Peter and St. Paul but he was a very close friend to St. Peter. When St. Peter died, Mark was asked to write down Peter's stories about Jesus, as Mark had heard them many times. His Gospel is the shortest of all the four Gospels but one that holds lots of little details about Jesus and Peter's friendship. Mark was made Bishop of Alexandria in Egypt. He preached the Gospel with his whole heart and shared about Jesus' great love. Many people became followers of Christ because of Mark's work. Mark suffered a painful death and was martyred for his faith in Jesus. His remains were placed in the basilica in the Piazza San Marco in Venice, Italy. He is the patron saint of Venice.

HOLY FATHER'S APRIL PRAYER INTENTION

We pray for those who risk their lives while fighting for fundamental rights under dictatorships, authoritarian regimes and even in democracies in crisis.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD

Today's gospel makes a comparison between the good shepherd, who lays his life down for the sheep, and the hired man, who is not a true shepherd and who only works for the pay. The good shepherd is motivated by his love for the sheep; he knows them and they know him. The hired man, however, has no ownership in the sheep and is motivated only by the money. He is unconcerned with the danger his sheep may encounter. This same metaphor can be applied to us in our discipleship. As we go about serving God's people in the church, do we do so out of love for the people we serve? Have we made every effort to develop a personal relationship with each of them? Or are we mostly dutiful in our service, acting only out of obligation and without concern about the people we serve? In either situation, the "sheep" recognize whether or not they are valued. Let us strive to be like the good shepherd in all aspects of life as a missionary disciple.

Feasibility Study

This past week Betty Johnson led us in a town-hall meeting where she shared the results of our feasibility study. She shared about the information gathered in her interviews and from her on-line survey that she made available to parishioners. All members of the parish were invited to participate. Below are stats she gathered from her study.

Participants in the study:	128
Well informed about project:	76% of participants
Project viewed as important:	75% of participants
Would consider volunteering for campaign:	57% of participants
Would consider a role on capital campaign:	62
Would consider leadership role on campaign:	5
Would consider making a financial gift:	90% of participants
Would consider an estate gift:	65% of participants
Amount we are projected to raise:	\$2.5 – 3.0 million

Betty also provided recommendations as part of the next steps:

1. Seek the bishop's permission to move into a capital campaign.
2. Engage in an all-inclusive educational phase to ensure that parishioners have the opportunity to understand the vision of the campaign.
3. Leadership for the campaign should be chosen.
4. Chair(s) for the campaign need to be selected.
5. Prayer for the success of the campaign and for those who will work hard to see it through.

At our town-hall meeting we also heard parishioners express their desire that we come together as a community during this process. I would like to echo that desire and ask all to pray for that unity as this process continues to the next step.

I am grateful to all parishioners who participated in this feasibility study. It is important to me to have a significant percentage of the parish involved in this process. Having your voice heard is important to me. Please join me in praying for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as this project continues.
