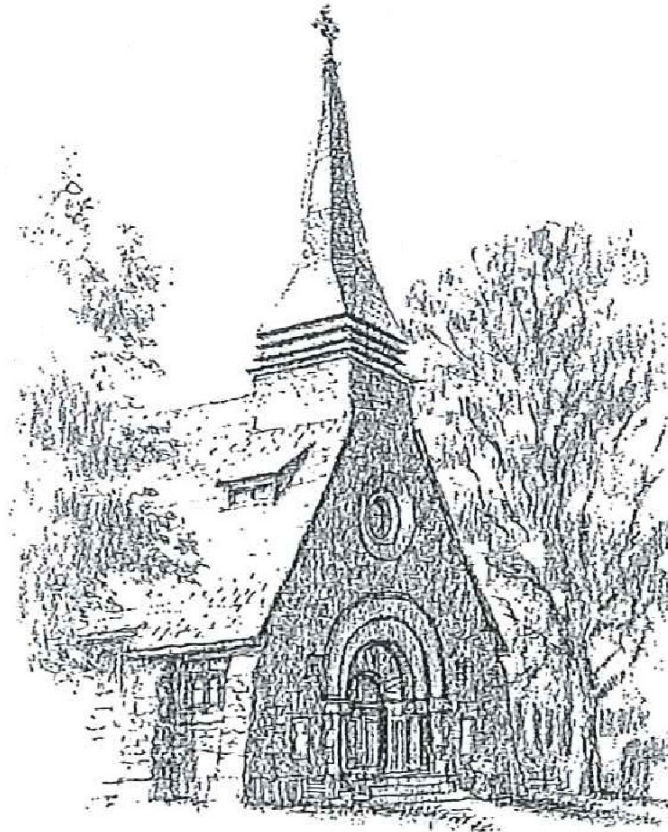

## **ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 17, SERVICES**

Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day, but many people enjoy attending Mass to give their observance of Lent a good start. ## **ASH WEDNESDAY REGULATIONS**

*Remember:* Ash Wednesday is a day of strict fast and abstinence. Persons over the age of 14 and under the age of 60, whose health, work or studies will not be adversely effected, are required to fast (one main meal, and two smaller meals, both together not equaling the main meal) and abstain from meat. Abstinence from meat is also required on all the Fridays of Lent. These age requirements are meant to be a guideline; everyone is encouraged to make this small sacrifice in this Holy Season.
