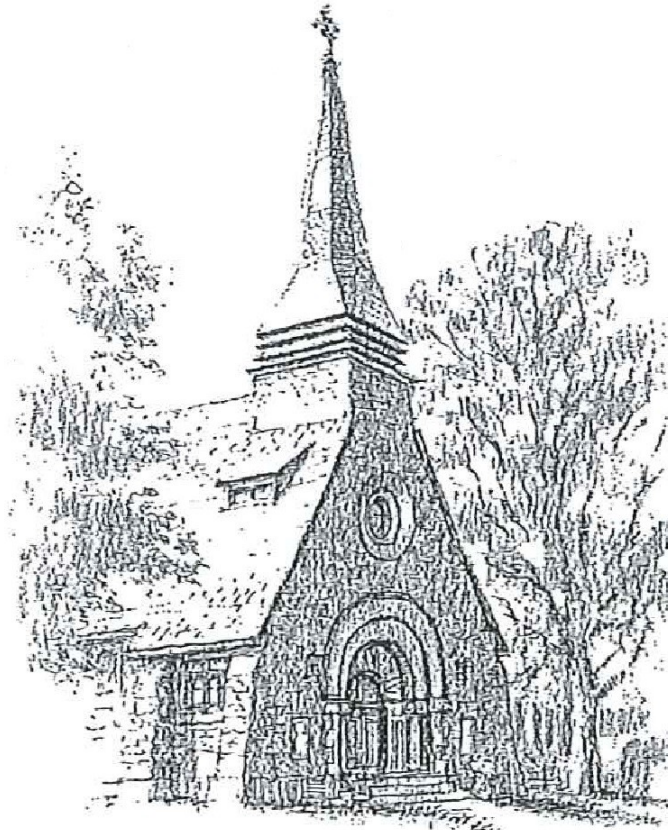

### **MARY’S MONTH, THE MONTH OF MAY**

It’s been a long-standing tradition in the Catholic Church to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary during the month of May. In many Catholic churches, a “May Altar” is erected with a statue or picture of Mary, flowers, and perhaps candles. The altar stands from May 1-31 as a reminder of Mary’s importance in the life of the Church and in our own lives as well. During this month of May, let us all rededicate ourselves to Mary, asking for her help and her protection. What better prayer to speak to her daily during this month than that written by Saint Bernard, his famous ‘*Memorare*’.

*Remember, Oh most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known, that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession, was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, we fly unto thee, oh Virgin, of virgins, our Mother. To thee do we come, before thee we stand, sinful and sorrowful, oh Mother of the Word Incarnate. Despise not our petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer us. Amen.*

### **MEMORARE TO ST. JOSEPH**

Remember, most pure spouse of Mary ever Virgin, my loving protector St. Joseph, that never has it been known that anyone invoked your protection or besought your aid without being consoled.
