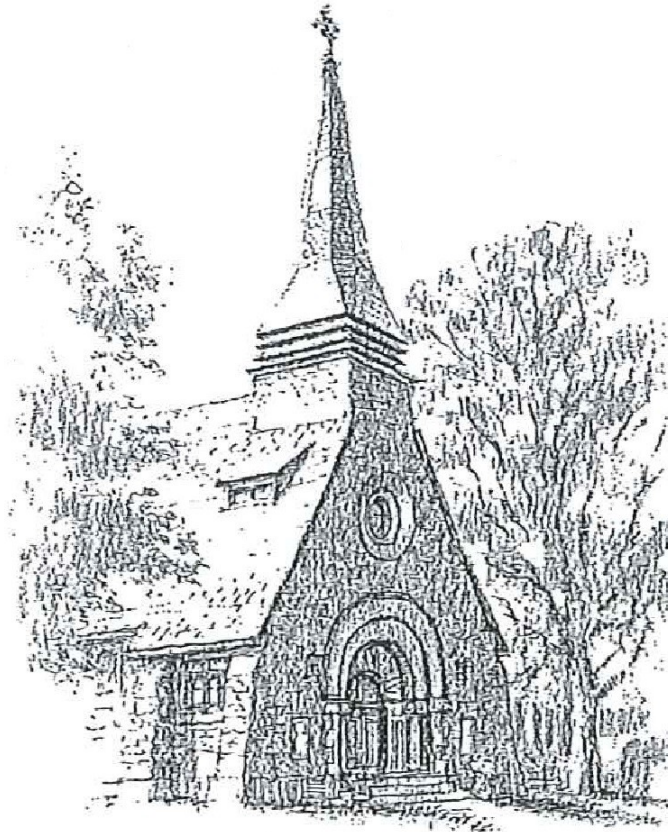

JULY 4TH PRAYER FOR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
