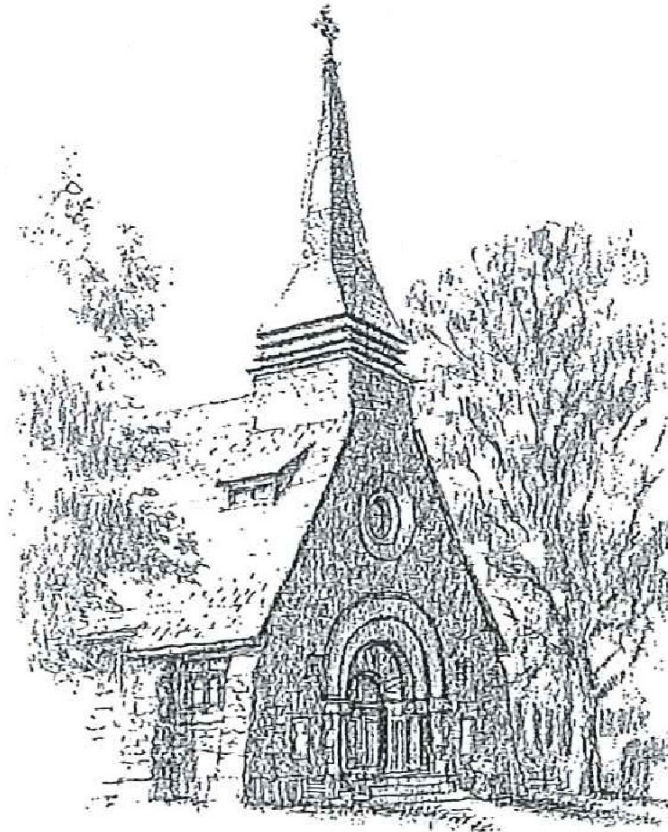

OCTOBER-MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7) was established by Pope St. Pius V in thanksgiving for the naval victory at Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The Ottoman Turks were preparing to land their troops in Italy, march on to Rome, murder the Pope, and make Rome their base for a Muslim conquest of Europe. The Holy Father asked everyone to pray the Rosary for a Christian victory. The Ottomans were defeated in the most decisive naval battle anywhere in the globe since the Battle of Actium in 31 BC. The Christians forces credited the victory to the Virgin Mary whose intercession with God they had implored for victory through the Holy Rosary.
