

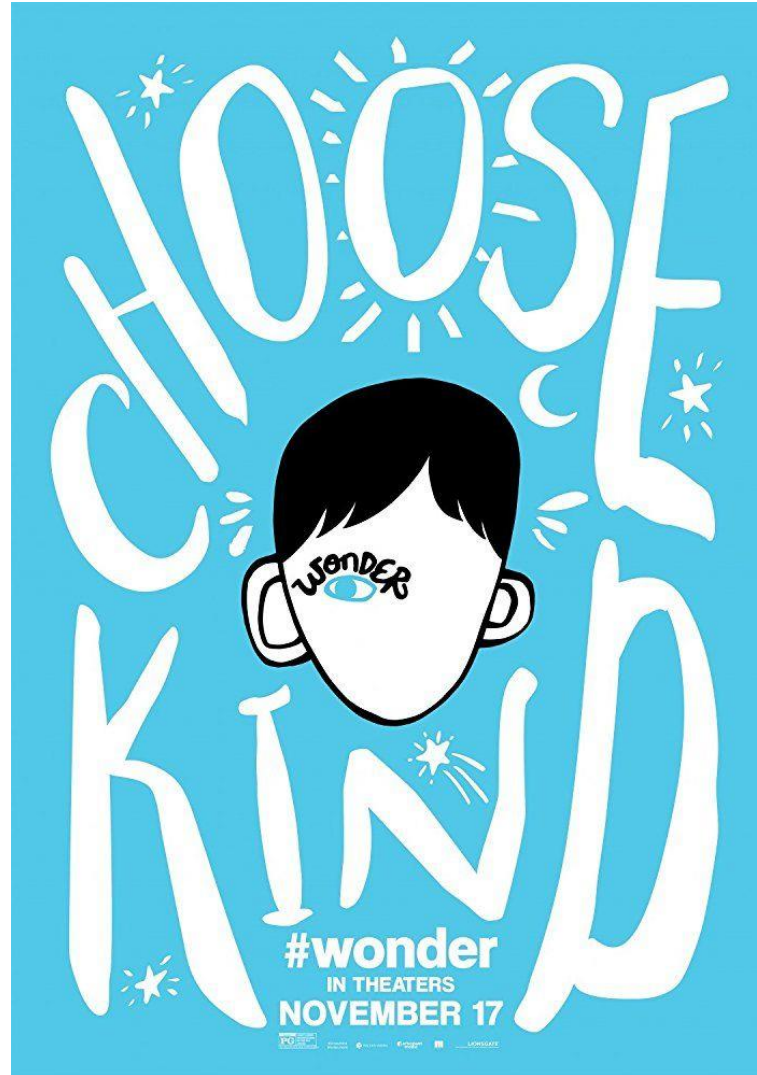

Elements of a Novel

- **Plot** – sequence of events
 - **Conflict** – struggle between opposing forces
 - Internal conflicts – within a character
 - External conflicts – between a character and another person or force
- Climax** – turning point in the story
- Resolution** – conflicts resolved or left intact

Elements of a Novel

- **Point of View** – author's choice of narrator
 - ***Wonder*** - 1st person, written from the point of view of several different narrators.

Elements of a novel

Characters – imaginary people or creatures

protagonist – main character

- Auggie

antagonist – character who is the cause of conflict for the main character

- Julian

Elements of a novel

- Theme – underlying message of the novel
 - The themes of Wonder have to do with kindness, friendship, differences and bullying.
 - All themes are about life and can be stated as a sentence.

Elements of a novel

- Setting – time and place of the story
 - New York City
 - During Auggie's 5th grade school year.

Figurative Language

Simile – a comparison of unlike things using “like” or “as”

Metaphor- a comparison of unlike things not using “like” or “as”

Personification – something not human is given human characteristics
