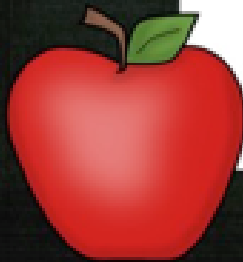


We Walk with Jesus K5A
