HOMEWORK / AGENDAS

Fifth grade students will be given homework each night. Homework will allow students the opportunity for independent practice of recently taught concepts. Homework will also play an important role in a student's academic success. Students will receive credit for completed work only. If homework is incomplete or not turned in on time the student will receive a zero in the grade book. Students will be given one day to turn in homework, it will be considered late and 10 points will be deducted from the homework grade.

Each student will receive an agenda book that must be kept in the student's binder. It is the responsibility of each student to copy all homework assignments each day. The word "NONE" will be written in each block with no assignment. Homework assignments will be posted on the website in case a student is absent.

ABSENCES

Please refer to the school handbook regarding absences. If a student is absent, he/she will have three days to make up all missing work. Students will receive a zero for any work not received in three days. Please notify the office if you want to pick up work for your student or you want work sent home with another student. Please call before lunch so teachers have time to get assignments together.

DAILY SNACKS

Fifth graders will have a daily snack as we eat lunch at noon. Healthy snacks would be great choices. Snacks should be eaten in about 5 minutes without being messy. No gum or candy allowed as it will be thrown away.

Students choosing not to embrace these expectations will receive the following:

First Offense - Student will receive a warning.

Second Offense - Student will sign the "Discipline Journal" and explain their behavior.

Third Offense - Student will sign "Discipline Journal" and sit out during recess.

Fourth Offense - Students will receive a "Saint Mary discipline report".

If a severe disruption occurs, the student will be sent directly to the office.

The student "Discipline Journal" is teacher monitored at all times. Each student will have a page used to document any classroom disruptions. When asked to sign the journal, the student will identify the rule broken and explain how the disruption occurred. Each entry will include the date and time the disruption occurred. If a student signs the journal 3 times in one week a Saint Mary write-up will be issued and sent home for parent signature. If a student receives 3 write-ups in one grading period, detention is automatically assigned.
