The church built in 1881, was erected to serve the farming communities of Leicester and Whiting. When it was first built, parishioners traveled by horse and buggy to the white clapboard church that sits at the edge of Leicester Whiting Road. There is good cause to give God thanks for the many graces received during its long history in this special place.
