**Bishop's Annual Appeal**

**Parish Goal \$12,300.05**

It is wonderful that Vermont is opening up even more and we are seeing more of you here at Mass. On behalf of Bishop Coyne, I thank you for your generosity to the parish and the Bishop's Appeal during this difficult year. When the churches shut down during the height of the pandemic, donations to the Bishop's Appeal allowed more than 200 faith activities to continue online, including daily and Sunday Mass, daily Adoration and rosary, bible study, retreats and so much more. We are asking you to prayerfully consider making a gift or pledge to the appeal.

The diocesan goal is \$2.5 million. 30 % of the raised goal will assist in the development of faith formation; 25% of the funds raised will subsidize our Catholic schools; 22% is allocated for Catholic ministries and services; 13% will be designated for use for Catholic Charities and the remaining 10% will be used to fund the communication endeavors of the diocese.

Envelopes and flyers are available at the back of the church if needed.

**Next Week's Changes**

While it is permissible to pass the basket for the collections, the present practice of parishioners placing their envelopes in the receptacles when entering the church will continue.

The church is required to make available hand sanitizer at the entrance of the church and in the sanctuary.

Next week the ropes ensuring social distancing will be removed. If it is your desire to maintain a distance from others, seating in a pew in the front of the church would better ensure that possibility.

While it is permissible to shake hands at the sign of peace, please be mindful that it is not required. Members of the community may desire an alternate gesture such as a bow from the waist.

Communion procession will be reinstated next week. The priest will take his position at the top of the center aisle. All should proceed to communion using the center aisle and return by the side aisles.

The recessional procession will be reinstated, and now that social distancing is not mandated, please refrain from leaving the church before the end of the song of departure. If it is your desire to maintain social distancing, please stay in your pew and after the congregation has left then depart.
