Dear friends:

Welcome back to our public Mass schedule.

Over the last two months we have been blessed to accomplish many things with your help.

First and most important is that we have kept the church open from 6am to 9pm with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every day since public Masses have been curtailed. The gift of our Lord present in the Holy Eucharist has drawn us to come to church and adore the God who became flesh among us. The spiritual treasures that have been poured into the parish and mission will be uncovered in the months and years ahead.

Later in this bulletin you will find a list of those times in the schedule that need to be filled with adorers so that the church always has someone of us praying before our Eucharistic King for our families, our parish, our Church and our nation. How wonderful and needful it is that we come before Him to plead for the multitude of spiritual and material needs that we have at this time.

To that end, ***I challenge every family to make a commitment to have a family member committed to pray in adoration for one hour once a week outside of Mass times.*** More than anything else, this commitment will cause the blessings of God to descend upon us. Please contact the parish office with your family's preferred day and time.

Second, improvements have been made. At St. Dominic, the parking lot has been paved with millings, the roof has been replaced and new gutters added, an outdoor drainage system has been installed with new grading, a dead oak tree has been removed and the bathroom door has been replaced. Work continues with replacing the sacristy exterior door, a repair to the stained glass, exterior paint on the windows and restoration of the bell tower, etc. At St. Michael, the hall has a new floor, there is beautiful new landscaping out front and around the Mary statue and the two front pews have been shortened to accommodate the need for more room for the casket during funerals. We owe a debt of gratitude to many parishioners, friends and benefactors who have made this all possible!

We have resumed our Sunday and Daily Masses.

The Sunday Mass schedule remains the same.

The daily Mass schedule has changed:

Mon/Wed/Fri - 7am

Tue/Thu/Sat – 8am

By now all of you are aware of the various and conflicting guidance given with regard to public health. With the proper use of your intellect and conscience, please exercise best practices. You will find every other pew in church roped off to provide separation between families. There will be four stations for receiving Communion kneeling at the communion rail only – two on each side.



Wait your turn and keep moving forward as the rail spaces become free. Families can come to the rail as a group; those who are unable to kneel may stand at the rail. Please return to your seat.

Archbishop Gregory has issued a dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. The Commandment to keep the sabbath holy as a day of rest cannot be dispensed.

The Adoration schedule will remain the same with the exception of the public Mass times taking up some of the Saturday and Sunday time slots. Come and adore!
