Dear friends:

QUIS UT DEUS!

This phrase is the literal meaning of the name Michael in Latin. In Hebrew, names often have an underlying significance. When a Hebrew name ends in “-el” it refers in some way to God. So, each of the Archangels have that detail in their name.

St. Raphael means the “Remedy of God”; from this we get some indication that St. Raphael has a special ability to bring healing. You can read all about St. Raphael’s healing office in the Book of Tobit. We find that he facilitates physical healing and plays a role in deliverance from demonic oppression.

St. Gabriel means “the Power of God” and this is particularly endearing when we consider that he was the messenger who announced to the Virgin Mary, regarding the Child to be born of her, that “He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High.” (Lk 1:32) The all-powerful God became a most vulnerable child in Mary’s womb.

St. Michael means “who is like God?” This is both the meaning of his name and an expression of veneration for his defense against the fallen spirits. We can expect his awesome protection whenever we call upon him.

This week we will celebrate the patronage of St. Michael on the feast of the Archangels, September 29. Whatever your battles in life are, you can be sure that the Archangel is waiting to provide encouragement and real help in the spiritual battle.

I urge you to memorize the St. Michael prayer that we say every day after Mass:

Saint Michael the Archangel defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray; and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits, who prowl throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

From this prayer you see the overarching responsibility that St. Michael has in the Church: he is to defend us in the battle with the fallen spirits who seek to cause our separation from God.

St. Michael, be our constant protection!
