I recently asked a woman who has been married for 47 years, "What is the secret that has kept you happily married?" She replied, "Patience. A lot of patience!" Arguably, we are wired to want more from a spouse than this. Perhaps topping the list of "most desired traits" are friendship, romance, trust, and safety. Sadly, traits like these fade with the passage of time, sickness, and death.

Our second reading from Paul is well-known (and sometimes controversial). In it, we read that Christ is married to his people. Though this truth is underappreciated, it is ripe with meaning. This unique and joyful love, which is completed only when we are united to Jesus in Heaven, begins on earth through a constant awareness of this abiding, spousal love.
