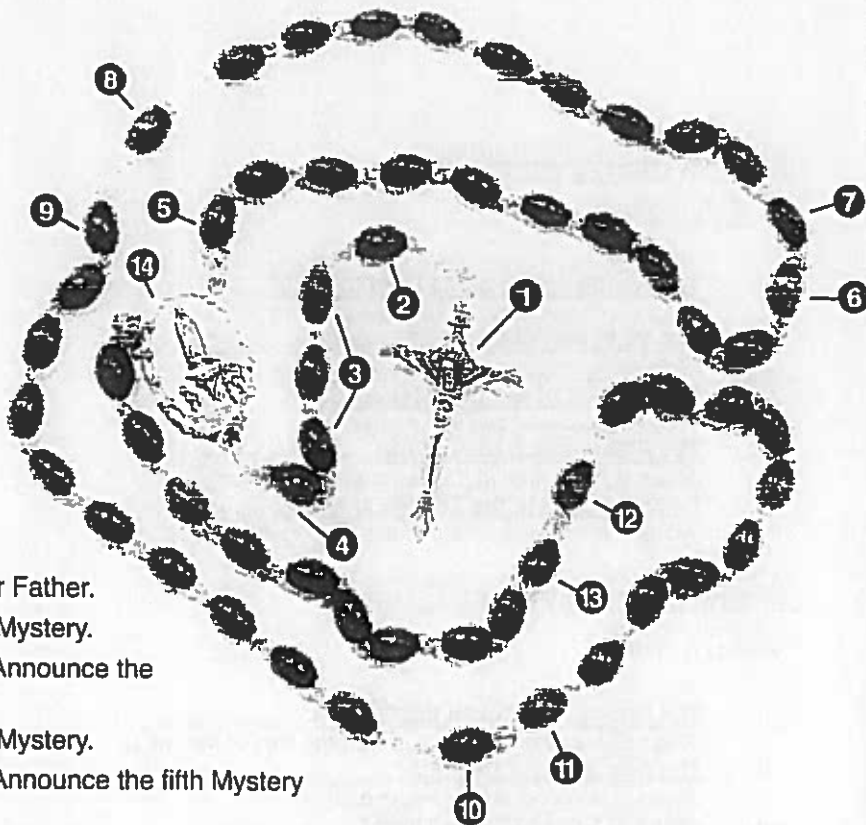


4. HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

6. Say the Glory Be. Say the Fatima prayers. Announce the second Mystery and say the Our Father.
7. Say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery.
8. Say the Glory Be. Say the Fatima prayers. Announce the third Mystery and say the Our Father.
9. Say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery.
10. Say the Glory Be. Say the Fatima prayers. Announce the fourth Mystery and say the Our Father.
11. Say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery.
12. Say the Glory Be. Say the Fatima prayers. Announce the fifth Mystery and say the Our Father.
13. Say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery.
14. Say the Glory Be. Say the Fatima prayers. Say the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel and the Hail Holy Queen.



PRAYERS OF THE ROSARY

Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. *Amen.*

The Apostles Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit. Born of the Virgin Mary, He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; he ascended into Heaven sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. *Amen.*

Our Father

Our Father, who art in Heaven; hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. *Amen.*

Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. *Amen.*

Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. *Amen.*

Fatima Prayers

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy Mercy. *Amen.*

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask forgiveness for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love Thee!

Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle; be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray: and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. *Amen.*

Hail, Holy Queen

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy, hail, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve: to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears. Turn then, most gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus, O merciful, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary! *Amen.*

JOYFUL MYSTERY OF THE ROSARY

Monday & Saturday

- I. **The Annunciation of the Lord to Mary**
Mary is chosen to be the mother of Jesus.
- II. **The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth**
Elizabeth recognizes Mary as the mother of our Lord.
- III. **The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ**
Jesus is born and laid in a manger.
- IV. **The Presentation of our Lord**
Jesus is presented in the Temple of Jerusalem.
- V. **Finding Jesus in the Temple at age 12**
Jesus is found discussing God's laws in the temple.

SORROWFUL MYSTERY OF THE ROSARY

Tuesday & Friday

- I. **The Agony of Jesus in the Garden**
Jesus prays when confronted with the sins of the world.
- II. **The Scourging at the Pillar**
Jesus is whipped before His execution.
- III. **Jesus is Crowned with Thorns**
Jesus is mocked with a painful crown of thorns.
- IV. **Jesus Carried the Cross**
Jesus carries the weight of our sins to His crucifixion.
- V. **The Crucifixion of our Lord**
Jesus Christ dies to save all mankind.

GLORIOUS MYSTERY OF THE ROSARY

Wednesday & Sunday

- I. **The Resurrection of Jesus Christ**
Jesus rises triumphant over death.
- II. **The Ascension of Jesus to Heaven**
As Jesus ascends, He gives us a special task.
- III. **The Descent of the Holy Ghost**
At Pentecost the Church is born.
- IV. **The Assumption of Mary into Heaven**
The Virgin Mary is gloriously assumed into heaven.
- V. **Mary is Crowned as Queen of Heaven and Earth**
Mary is honored above all creatures.

Thursday

- I. **The Baptism in the Jordan**
God proclaims Jesus is His Son.
- II. **The Wedding at Cana**
Jesus performs a surprising miracle at a wedding.

- IV. **The Transfiguration**
Jesus is gloriously transformed.
- V. **The Institution of the Eucharist**
Jesus shares His Body and Blood for our salvation.
