

STP PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
MINUTES OF JANUARY 25, 2021

- Meeting commenced at 7:32 p.m.
- Roll call was taken in joint meeting.
- Minutes were approved for the November, 2020 meeting – Pat S. made the motion, Paul seconded the motion, minutes were unanimously approved.
- Fr. John discussed Stations of the Cross. Fr. John would like to lead on February 19, 2021. Fr. Clyde will lead as well. Paul R., Jeanne G., volunteered to lead. Paul R. will speak to Sally Prohaska about volunteering. Dates have not been established. Dawn M. volunteered her daughter, Angela, to carry the cross if no one is available. A schedule will need to be determined in order to notify all volunteers.
- There may not be a parish picnic in July. Carol Silvay will not be able to plan due to unforeseen issues. A discussion was had among Council, and it was agreed that due to the pandemic the picnic might not be held this year for safety reasons. Council did discuss the possibility of having some sort of ice cream social or other event, if it could be done safely, and draw the raffle ticket winners at the same time. Council will discuss the picnic at the February meeting.
- There will not be a public Mass for St. Patrick's Day this year due to the Pandemic. Fr. John is looking into recording mass live and streaming to social media.
- Pat S. suggested that we put up tables in the back of the Church near the statue of St. Joseph and request donations of canned goods for the hunger center in honor of the Feast (March 19, 20 and 21). This would be published in the bulletin.
- Jeff Q. gave an update on the Pizza bake-off. It may be scheduled in June and would be outside in the church parking lot.
- The annual car show is scheduled for August 4, 2021 in the parking lot.
