

General Parish Information

Anointing of the Sick: Speak to the pastor to determine if now is the right time to receive this sacrament. The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is usually preceded by the sacrament of confession. For sacramental emergencies (someone is near death), call parish's office at (205) 833-0334 at any time, day or night or contact David Renda, parish's minister of the sick & homebound.

Baptism: Contact Fr. Vu – preferably during the pregnancy to make arrangement

Marriage: Contact Fr. Vu at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process

Parish Registration: Speak to an usher or stop by the parish office to get the form to register.

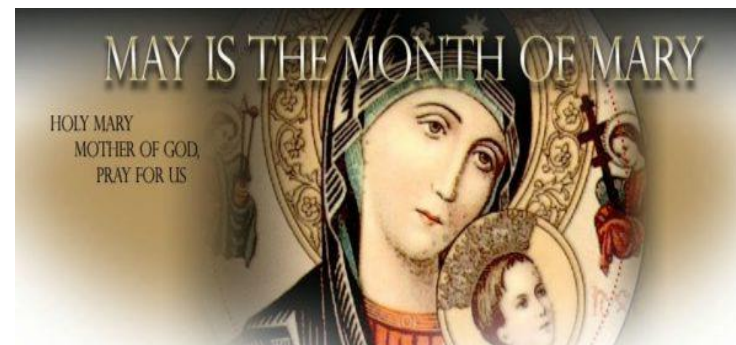

Easter: Regina Caeli - (From Easter Eve until the last Sunday of Easter.)
