Phase II - School Modelers, Site Improvements	\$ 1,400,000
Emergency Roof Replacement/Seismic Upgrades	\$ 300,000
Baptismal Bowl-(donor support)	\$ 10,000
Stain Glass Window Phase I-(donor support)	\$ 102,600
Stain Glass Window Phase II-(partial donor support)	\$ 46,300

### DEBT SERVICE

\$6,500,000 is the total amount of the loans that the church has taken on since 2001. This does not include school construction. *The good news is we only owe \$900,000.* The Debt Service collection relates to loan payments for the construction of Koinonia Room, accessibility upgrades, the addition of the library, the Sophie Chapel and enlarging the choir area. Our monthly loan payments are \$14,700 or \$176,400 per year. Any short fall in Debt Service donations comes from the operational budget.
