

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR MASS?

Please remember a general dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation remains in place.

Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk. Vulnerable, at-risk and otherwise concerned persons should remain home. Those who attend should be made aware of government regulations regarding potential mandatory quarantine if a fellow attendee subsequently tests positive for COVID-19.

Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness must remain home. It is strongly encouraged that each person conduct a voluntary self-assessment of their health as a pre-condition for attending Mass.

MASS SCHEDULE

WHEN: SATURDAY, VIGIL MASS AT 5:30 PM OR SUNDAY MASS AT 11 AM

We will have Mass every Saturday at 5:30 pm and Sunday at 11 am Please be sure to check the website, Facebook page or call the parish office for updates. We will livestream this Mass on Facebook Live and our main website page. The times may change depending on the weather and other scheduling so please watch the website and bulletin for information.

Shake hands, hug, kiss or gather in groups

Indoor Mass Guidelines

*Mass will look and feel and sound different!
But we will be together to hear the Word of the Lord and to receive Eucharist together.*

There will be some noticeable changes to the Mass due to health and safety concerns but also some necessary changes due to the fact we are celebrating outdoors.

- ◆ All attendees must wear masks and observe social distancing at all times.
- ◆ Please sit in your assigned seat.
- ◆ Now that we are indoors please observe normal postures of sitting, standing and kneeling during Mass.
- ◆ No collection will be taken during the Mass (instead, baskets will be placed near the entrance and exit)
- ◆ Congregational singing is not allowed at this time and Choirs are not permitted.
- ◆ Cantors may be used but at this time only the 5:30 pm Inside Mass will have a cantor. Ann will wear a mask during singing and will sing hymns we know. However please do not join in the singing. However, if you would
- ◆ All Masses are live streamed including this evening. We stop livestreaming however just before Communion.

Celebration of the Mass

- ◆ Fr. Tony will not wear a Mask during the celebration of the Mass.
- ◆ Fr. Tony and other liturgical ministers will maintain social distancing of 6-12 feet.
- ◆ No presentation of the gifts by the faithful.
- ◆ Please refrain from holding hands at the Our Father—please just bow
- ◆ Please refrain from shaking hands at the sign of peace.
- ◆ The only Eucharistic elements that will be immediately in front of the priest during the Eucharistic prayer and Consecration are the Eucharist elements that he himself will consume. Hosts to be consecrated for the faithful will be in a separate ciborium on the side of the altar.
- ◆ There will be no distribution of the Precious Blood.
- ◆ Communion will only be given in the hand.
- ◆ Communion distribution has returned to its normal time during the Mass.
- ◆ The Presider and Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks for distribution of Communion. Please wear your mask as you come forward to receive then remove your mask after saying “Amen” and step forward to receive the Eucharist. Please line up only when the usher indicates you may do so
- ◆ Please depart immediately after Dismissal. Please do not gather in the Narthex or parking lot

Practical Considerations

- ◆ Bulletins and the worship aids will be available prior to Mass.
- ◆ There will be no social gatherings before or after Mass.
- ◆ Childcare is not available.
- ◆ The Church is open for private prayer on Sundays from 12:30 pm - 2pm. See the website for other prayer times.
- ◆ Confession is available every Saturday from 4 pm - 5 pm in the Koinonia Room. Privacy screens are in place. Please sit in social distanced chairs. You do not need to register or sign in for Confession
