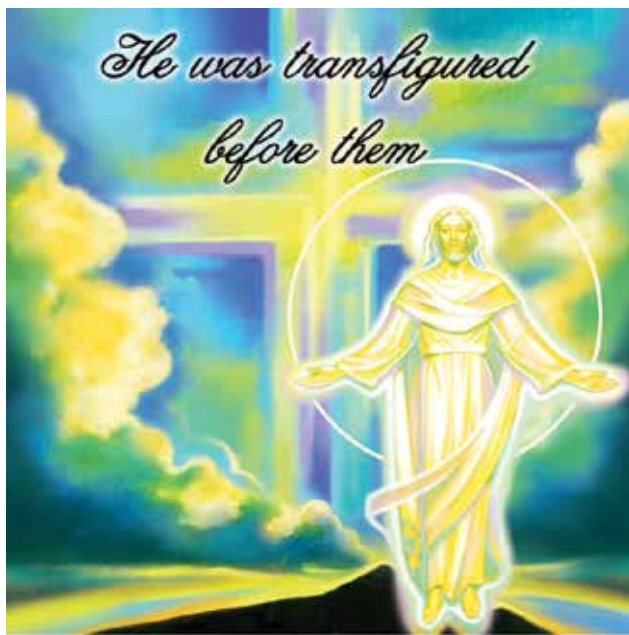

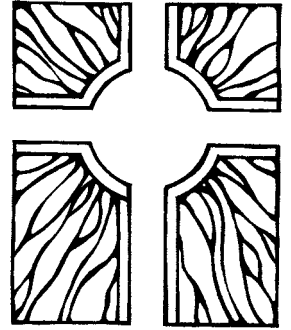
Father Mark's Corner

Italian-American Traditions are Celebrated on the Feast of St. Joseph

The St. Joseph Table is an Italian-American tradition of Sicilian-Americans and other immigrants from southern Italy celebrated on or around St. Joseph's feast day (March 19). It is a two-day celebration with a spaghetti dinner on Saturday night and sale of bread, wine and pastries.

In the 1200s, a series of severe droughts hit their lands and brought a lot of suffering. The landowners in their prayers to St. Joseph promised to open their homes to the poor if he would decide with God to end the drought.

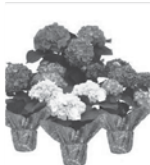

Talk about chat room dangers with your teen

Online chat rooms are great places for people to connect over shared interests and ideas. But for young children and teenagers who may not be internet-savvy, they're also a great place for predators to lay groundwork.

In a chat room, anyone can be whomever they want — and predators hide behind personas of friends. Talk to your child about online safety rules, such as never agreeing to meet in person and never providing personal and identifying information. Review chats frequently to ensure that your child is engaging in safe conversations.
