

About the Baptismal Process

The Sacrament of Baptism is a wonderful beginning for the spiritual life of your child. This is the time to focus on the reasons you have chosen Baptism for your child and how you can raise your child in a Christ-centered family.

Baptism preparation classes are required for both parents and godparents. It is a two-part process. Parents and godparents are required to take an on-line course prior to attending a one- night class in the Church.

The on-line class takes approximately 30 minutes to complete and may be completed at your leisure. Certificate of completion will be required for the class attendance. Please contact the parish office for more details and log-in information

If you are unable to attend class at St. Luke, you may attend at another parish and provide proof of attendance.

We request that parents and Godparents get a baby-sitter for the evening. This may be your only time without distractions to focus on the reasons you have chosen

Godparent Requirements:

The Church requires that at least one godparent (Sponsor) be a practicing Catholic, at least 16 years of age, Confirmed, and, if married, is married in the Church. The other godparent can be a fully initiated Catholic (sponsor) or a professed Christian (Christian Witness

Place of Baptism and Parish Registration:

The Sacrament of Baptism should take place in the parish where you are registered. A registration form to become a parishioner is available with the baptismal registration packet which can be picked up from the Pastoral Office or the links on this page. This will enable us to register you if you are not currently registered, or update the files if you are already registered.

If you live within the boundaries of another parish, a standard authorization letter from that parish will be needed.
