

#### Prayer to the Holy Trinity

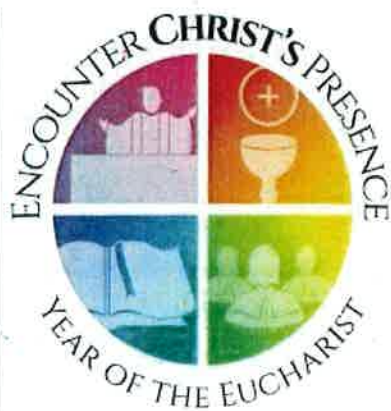
Glory be to the Father, Who by His almighty power and love created me, making me in the image and likeness of God.
