Dear Parishioners,

Since the arrival of the coronavirus in March, Bishop Cahill has issued a dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday mass. After much discernment, the Bishop has decided to **reinstate the Sunday obligation to attend mass, beginning the weekend of October 4<sup>th</sup>**. This means that if a person is reasonably capable of attending Sunday mass, they are obligated to. If it is unreasonable for a person to come to mass due to being sick or in poor/declining health, they are still dispensed and should not come to mass. Due to the expected increase in mass attendance, and the continue need for social distancing, we will create an overflow section in the St. Michael's parish hall for the 10AM mass. There will be a live video feed and the distribution of Holy Communion. For the time being, **we are still requiring the use of masks at ALL masses**. In addition to this we will continue to have every other row of pews blocked off for the sake of social distancing. If you are not sitting with people of your same household, please remember to keep adequate distance. Hand sanitizer will be available near the main entrance of the church. Please be mindful during communion to keep your distance between others and receive communion one pew at a time. Please be mindful of those around you and follow the precautions to ease anxieties of our Brothers and Sisters in Christ. However, if you have any symptoms, are feeling sick or have been in contact with someone who has contracted COVID-19, please stay home and keep holy the Sabbath Day and make an effort to sanctify your Sunday with prayer and reflection. We encourage everyone who is healthy to attend Mass.

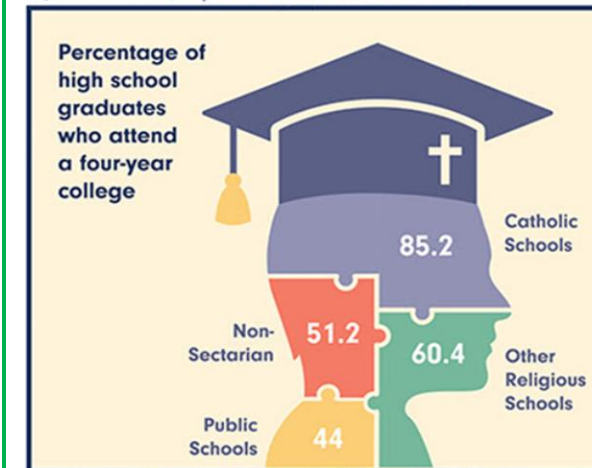

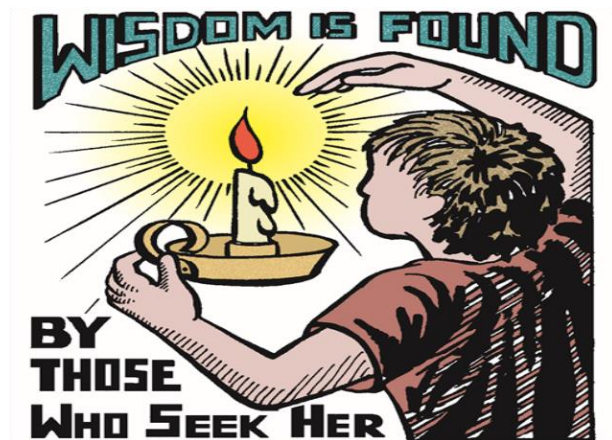
**St. Michael School News**
