1. HEAR

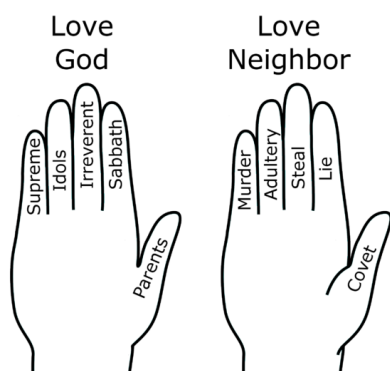
Options to Read/Listen to the Gospel

2. PRAY

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks the two most important commandments to keep: Love of God and Love of Neighbor.

Children: Write down the names of people you want to pray for. Ask Jesus to show you how you can show them love.

Teens: Think of people around you who may have a hard time loving themselves right now. Ask Jesus to show you ways you can show them how God sees them.

Young Adults and Adults: Last week we prayed about how to be a faithful citizen during elections and how to talk with those who have different opinions than us. Ask Jesus to help you identify a person in your life who shares different values than you. Challenge yourself to discern new ways you can show love to this person (neighbor) this week. Take some prayerful time with Jesus to process the experience(s) with your neighbor.

3. TALK

Share with your family or a trusted friend how you've shared God's love to your neighbors.

Everyday this week, make a plan to show love, generosity, and kindness to those who are around you.
