



NEW GUIDELINES FOR MASS ATTENDANCE

(Page 1)

9:30 am Mass in the Quad

Seating

- Our dedicated team of ushers will continue to set up chairs before Mass. You can enter the quad through any gate, but we will continue to maintain the current seating sections to the best of our ability.

Masks and singing

- No one is required to wear a mask outdoors, whether you are vaccinated or not.
- Singing will continue, even without masks.

Eucharist

- The ministers of Communion will continue to bring the Eucharist to you in your seats.

5pm Saturday Mass and 12pm & 7 pm Sunday Masses in the Basilica

Seating

- Although there is no restriction on capacity, pews will be marked to designate where to sit so that there is some physical distancing maintained. The new configuration will allow for more people to sit in the pews than before.

Masks and singing

- If you have been vaccinated you do not need to wear a mask indoors. However, non-vaccinated persons, including minors, must wear masks indoors.
- Singing will be allowed at these Masses.

Eucharist

- Ushers will escort you into the main aisle to process to the minister to receive the Eucharist. If you are unable to enter the line, please signal an usher and a minister of Communion will come to you.

7:30am Sunday Mass in the Basilica

Seating

- Seating will be the same as the 5pm and 12pm Mass

Masks and singing

- To offer an indoor option with less risk, this Mass will be a spoken Mass only and will not employ singing. Vaccinated persons do not need to wear a mask, but non-vaccinated persons do.

Eucharist

- A line will form in the main aisle, like at the 5pm and 12pm Mass.

8:30 am Daily Mass in the Basilica

Seating

- Same as Sunday Masses

Masks and singing

- If you have been vaccinated you do not need to wear a mask indoors. However, non-vaccinated persons, including minors, must wear masks indoors.
- Singing may take place at this Mass on occasion.

Eucharist

- A line will form in the main aisle, like at the Sunday Masses.
