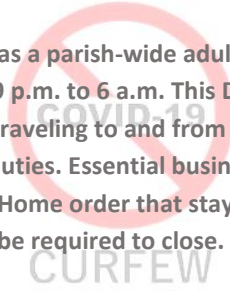

St. Landry Parish has a parish-wide adult and juvenile curfew every day from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. This DOES NOT INCLUDE essential workers traveling to and from work or as needed to perform their duties. Essential businesses listed in the Louisiana's Stay at Home order that stay open past 9 p.m. will not be required to close. (KATC)



STAY AT HOME ORDER

YOU CAN...

- Go to the grocery, convenience or warehouse store
- Go to the pharmacy to pick up medications and other healthcare necessities
- Go to medical appointments (check with your doctor or provider first)
- Go to a restaurant for take-out, delivery or drive-thru
- Care for or support a friend or family member
- Take a walk, ride your bike, hike, jog and be in nature for exercise — just keep at least six feet between you and others.
- Walk your pets and take them to the veterinarian if necessary
- Help someone to get necessary supplies
- Receive deliveries from any business which delivers

YOU SHOULD NOT...

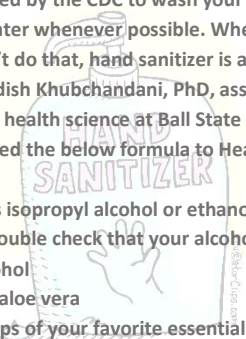
- Go to work unless you are providing essential services as defined by this Order
- Visit friends and family if there is no urgent need
- Maintain less than 6 feet of distance from others when you go out
- Visit loved ones in the hospital, nursing home, skilled nursing facility or other residential care facility, except for limited exceptions as provided on the facility websites.

CDC-Approved Hand Sanitizer- First, it's recommended by the CDC to wash your hands with soap and water whenever possible. When you are out and can't do that, hand sanitizer is a good backup. Jagdish Khubchandani, PhD, associate professor of health science at Ball State University recommended the below formula to Healthline.Com.

Ingredients:

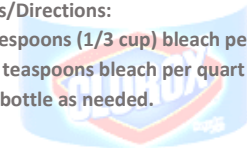
1. Two parts isopropyl alcohol or ethanol. Be sure to check and double check that your alcohol is 91 to 99 percent alcohol
2. One-part aloe vera
3. A few drops of your favorite essential oil (optional)



CDC-Approved Bleach Spray-The bleach spray can of course be applied directly onto many surfaces (be sure to read up on the materials bleach can ruin), but it can also be used to make "wipes" by saturating a folded paper towel with it and using that to wipe down items you bring into the house.

Ingredients/Directions:

Mix 5 Tablespoons (1/3 cup) bleach per gallon of water or 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water. Pour into spray bottle as needed.
