**Congratulations to all our graduates. We hope to have a celebration to honor all of them once we are back to Mass on Sundays.**

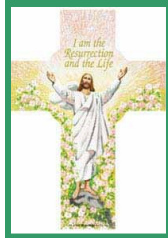
