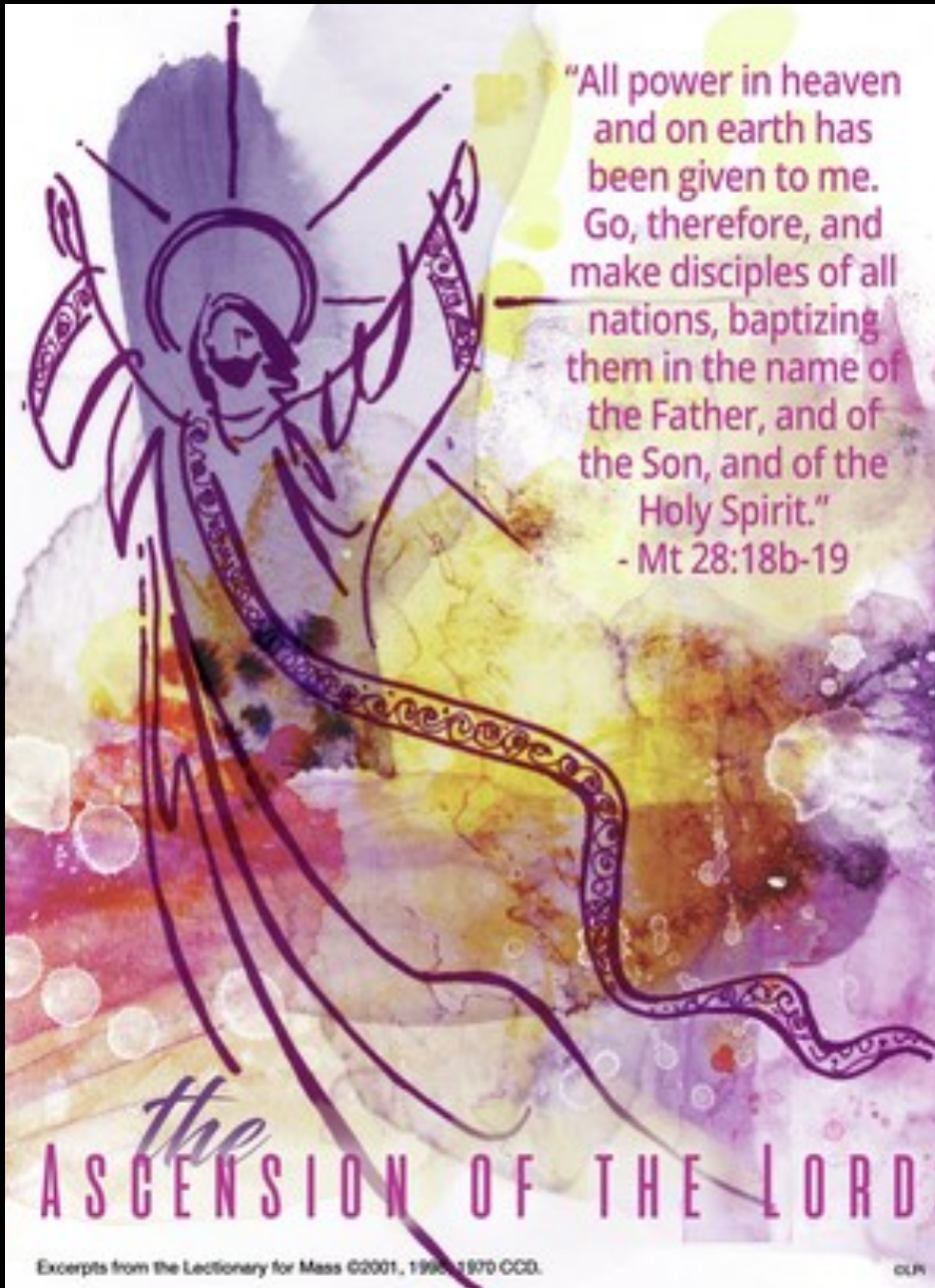

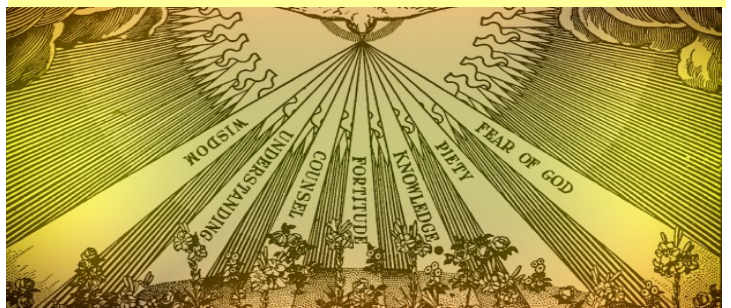
The Church is **open** daily from 9AM till 2PM and the Gift Shop is **open**

Holy Spirit Novena begins today. There is a special Novena prayer folder found in the entrance of the church for those who would like to make this Novena at home.

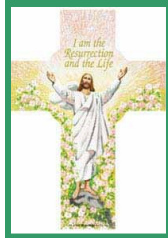

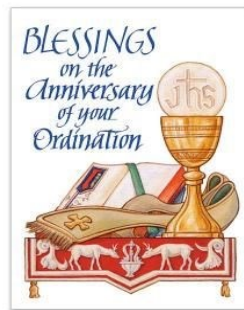
