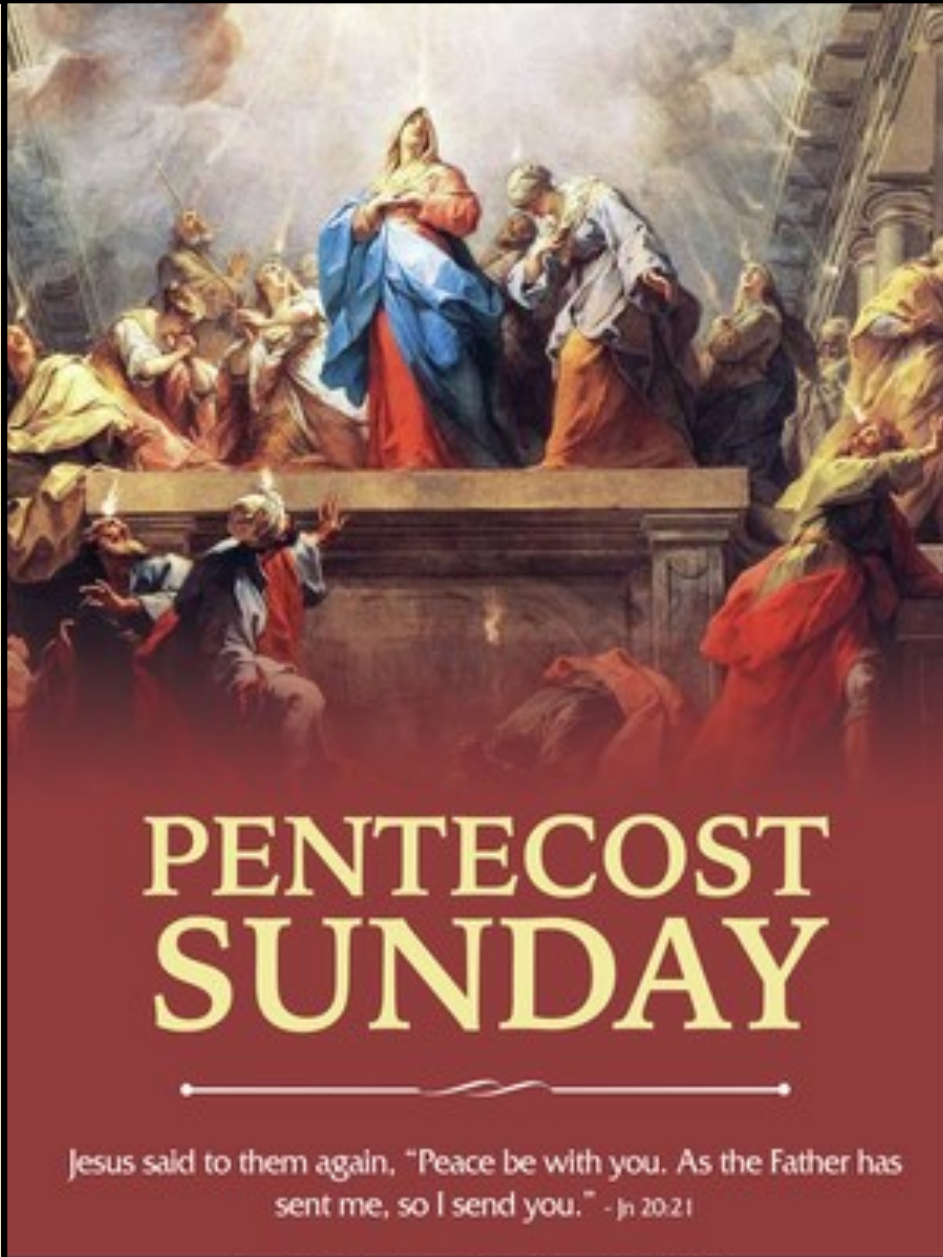

We will have a date for our Confirmation Class in a week.

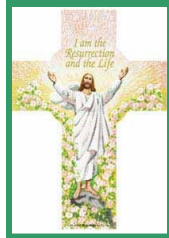

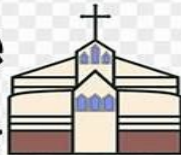
