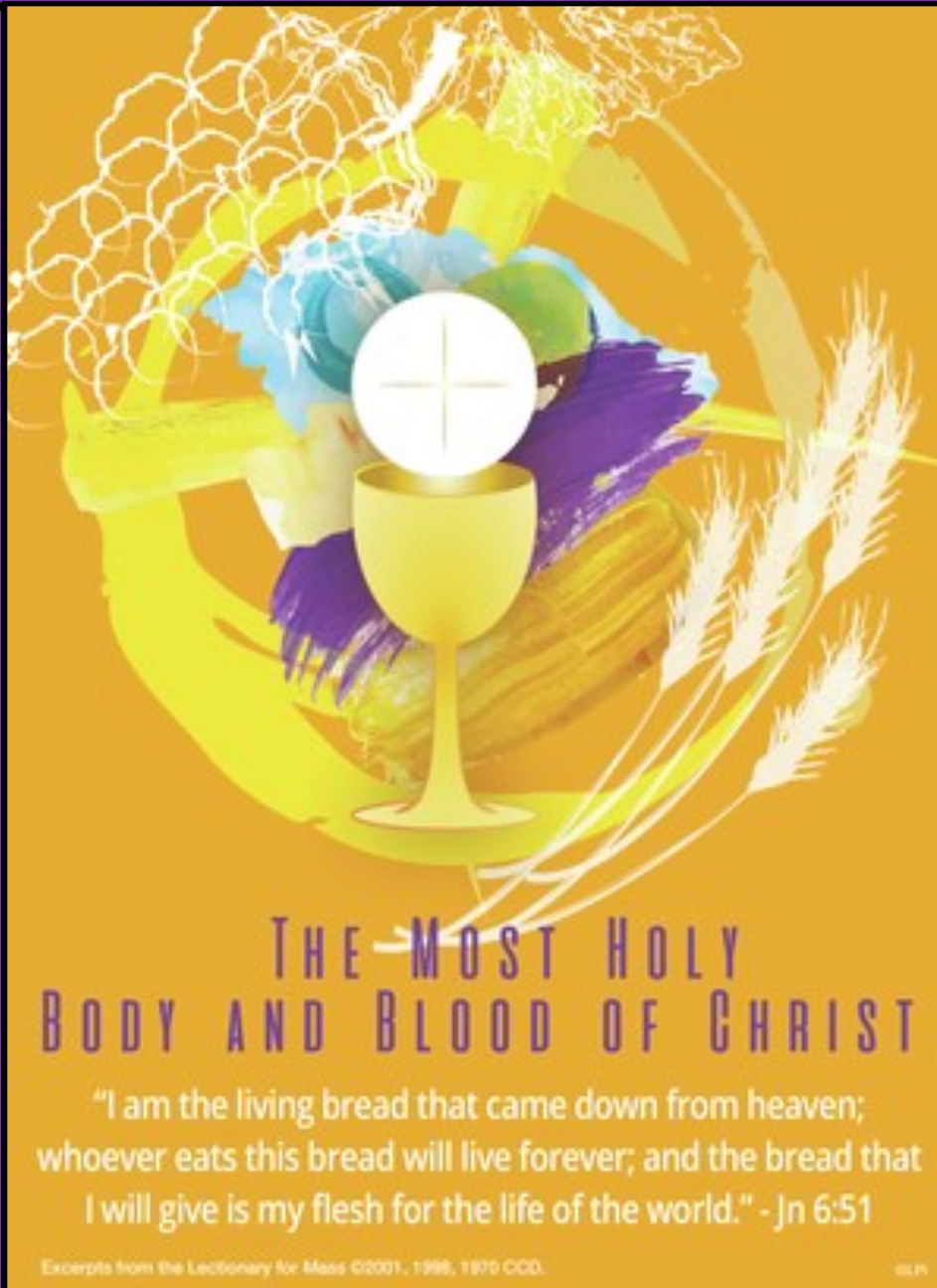

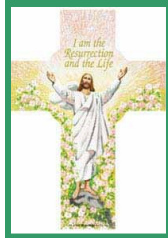
We have a date for our Confirmation Class July 1st, 7pm at St. Stephens Church. It had been postponed due to the pandemic.
