On December 8th the church celebrated the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a beautiful celebration not only for the Church of the United States of America but also for the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate (OMI), who continue to serve in New Orleans and around the world. Please pray for the OMI's all around the world.

On December 12th we celebrate at the 4PM Mass the Feast of the Our Lady of Guadalupe, which is the patronal feast of our parish but also of the Americas. 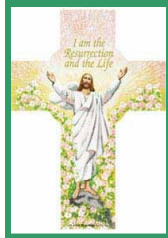

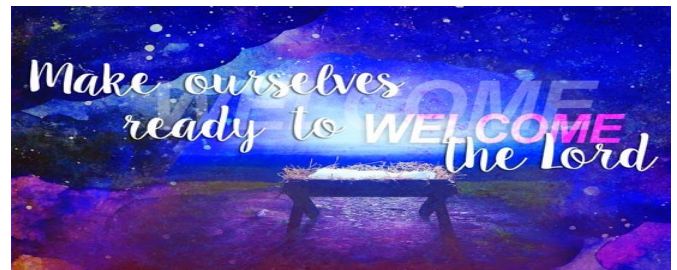
