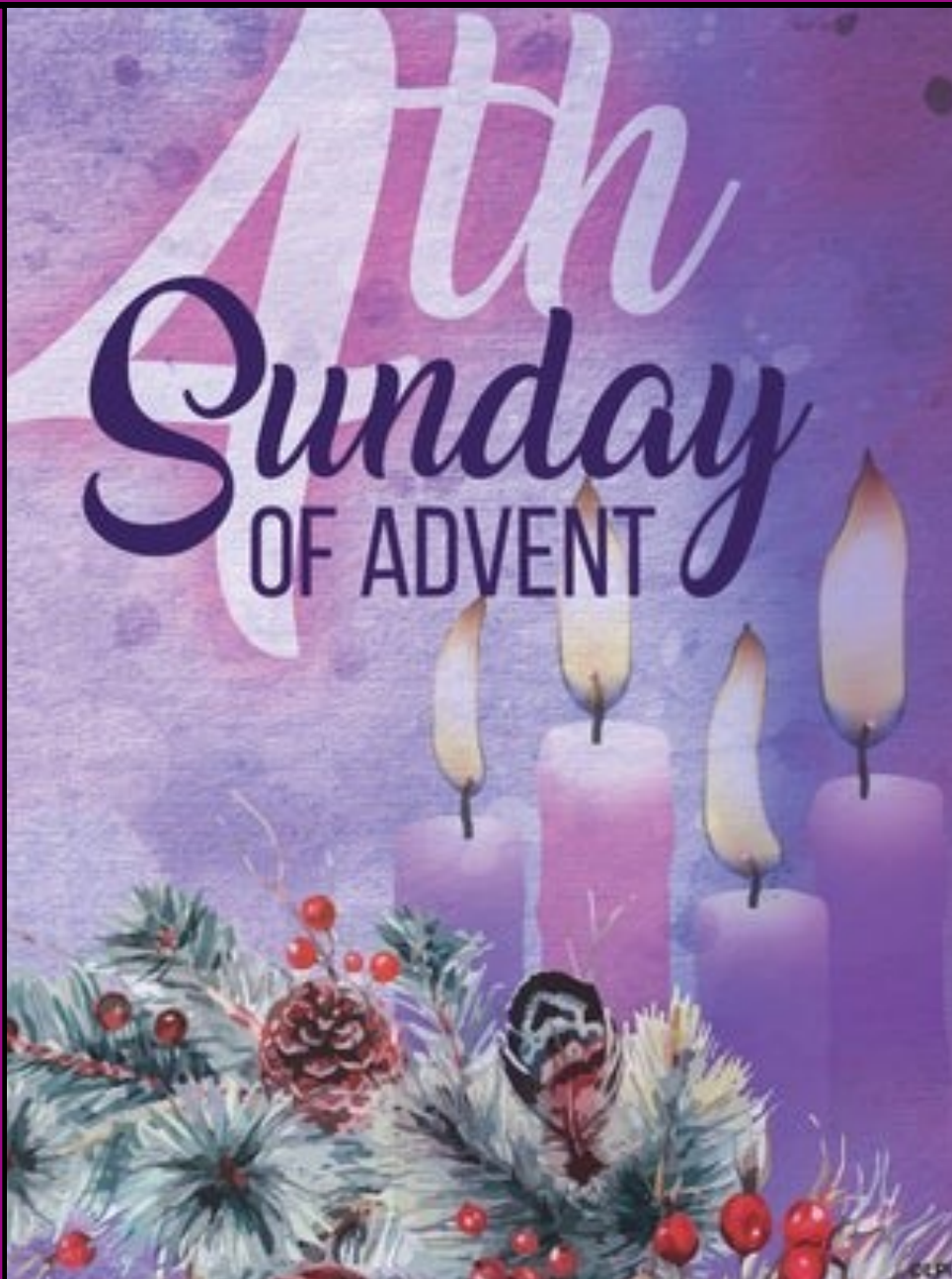

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of Guadalupe,

With just five days to go until Christmas, we are called today to focus on the Birth of Jesus. The Gospel for today shares the story of how the birth of Jesus came about. We hear for the first time the role that Joseph played in His Birth.

Joseph struggled with the entire situation. He must have asked: "Why is this happening and how will this turn out?" After awakening from a dream, like Mary, he was able to say: "Thy will be done".

Mary and Joseph are true models of faith. We, too, go through times when we ask: How will this turn out? In the midst of our confusion and doubts, let us be able to say: "Thy Will Be Done"!

On Christmas Eve, Thursday, Dec. 24th we will have two Masses at 4PM. One Mass will be in the Church and the other Mass will be in St. Jude Hall. The Mass in the Hall will be live with music, etc. We realize that many attend this Mass and we want to make sure we are keeping with social distancing and wearing masks.

We will also have Midnight Mass preceded by choir and Christmas caroling. This will begin at 11:30PM. We will have security so that everyone feels safe. On Christmas Day, Masses will be at 7:30AM, 9:30AM and 11:30AM.

Confessions will be available on Wed. Dec. 16th at 7PM and also on Christmas Eve at 11AM. We will also have our regular schedule of confessions prior to each weekend Mass. Once again, I invite all of us to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Give yourself the gift of peace by coming to Confession.

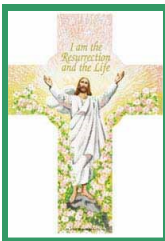

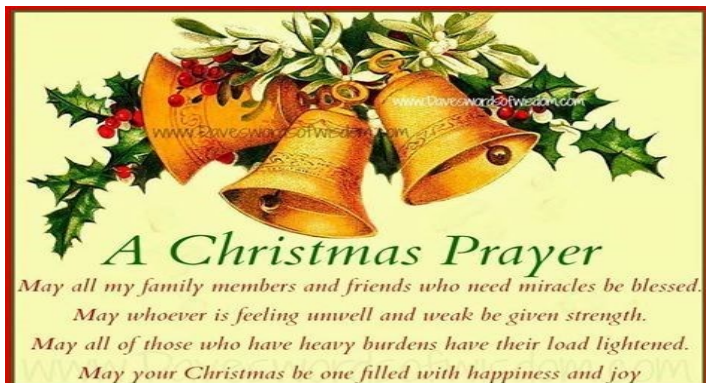
