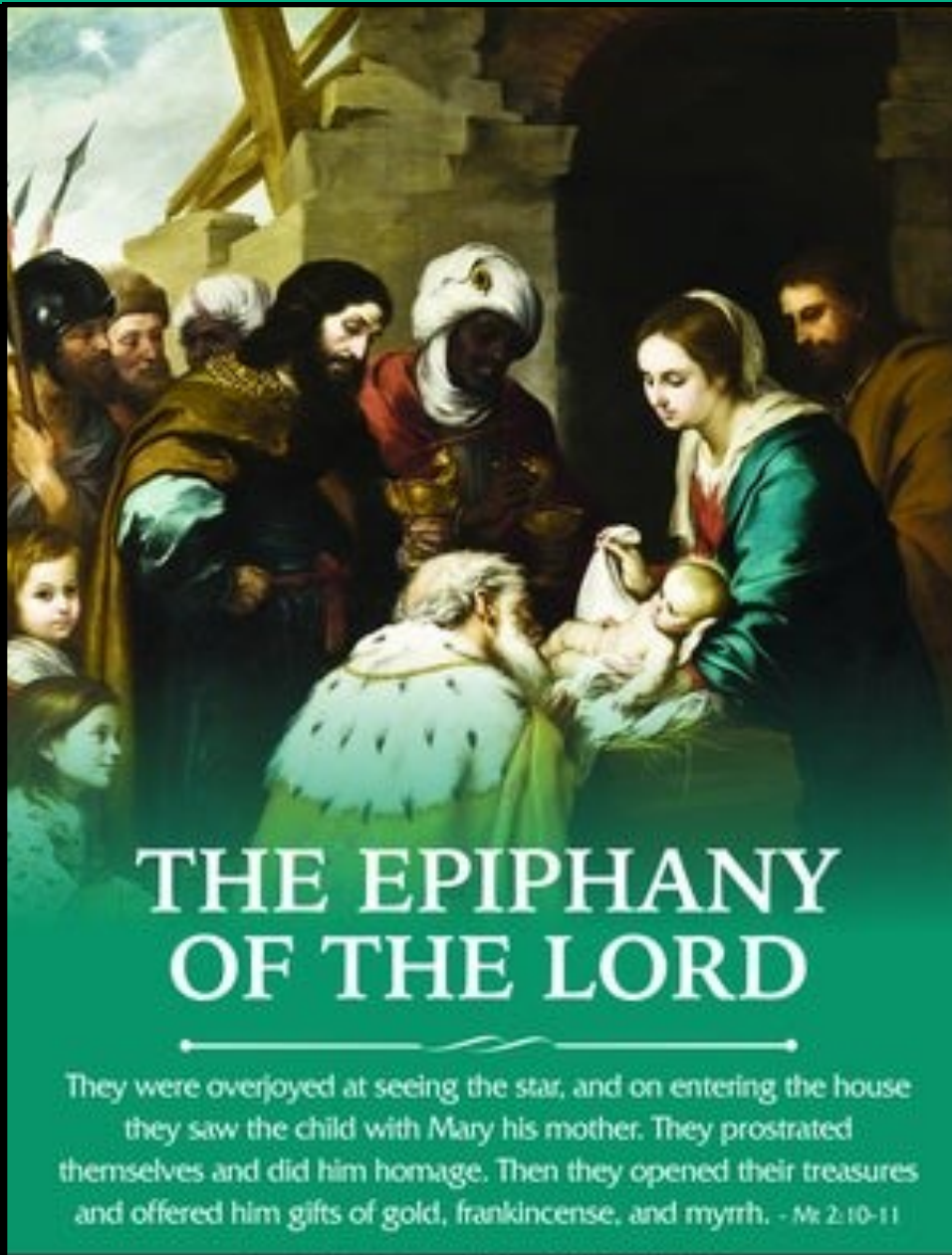

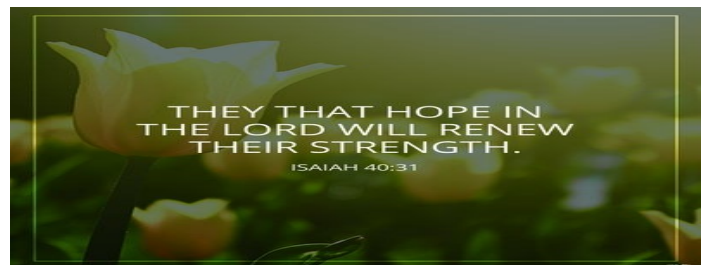
Our Lady of Guadalupe Scholarship Committee 2021

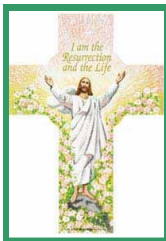
