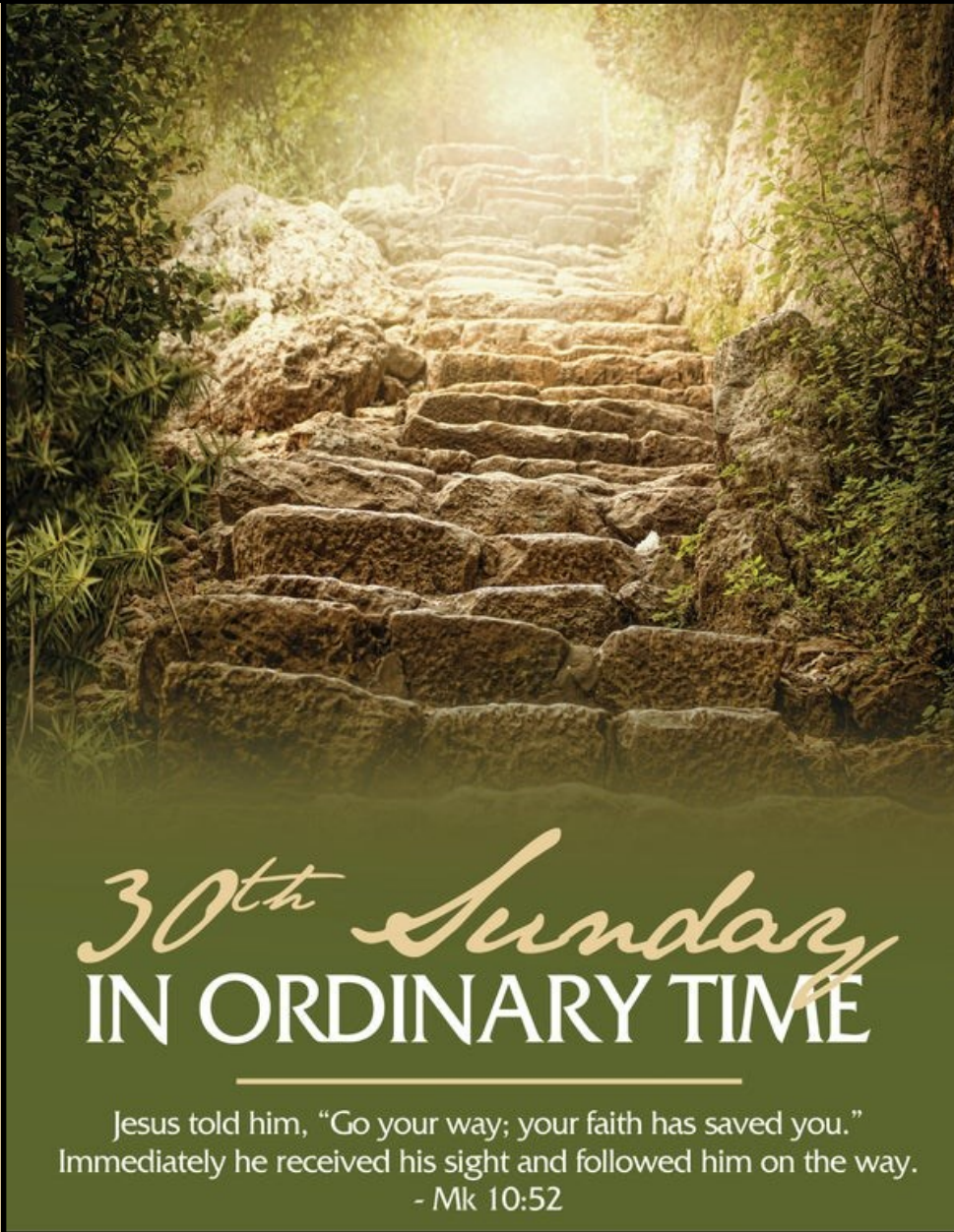

Remembering our Deceased Loved Ones....the month of November is set aside to remember our loved ones who have gone before us.

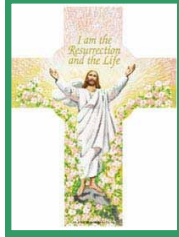
