Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest Booklets and Instruction

During the first few weeks of May, Father Murphy wants to disseminate the booklets created by the diocese about Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest. It is important for parishioners to understand the difference between a Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest and a Sunday Mass.

From time to time when our priests may not be available to preside at a Mass, we may need to offer instead a Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest. Please be sure to read carefully one of the booklets available in your church. Our preference is always to offer Mass, but there may be times when that may not be possible. We are blessed that at those times we can have the Sunday Celebration in the Absence of the Priest so we can still share God's word together on a Sunday, and if there is enough Eucharist available, still share the Eucharist together. Thank you for your continued support of our priests with your prayers.

Eagle Scout Project – Carpet Replacement at St. Ambrose Church, Richmond



Joseph Valliere, Boy Scout Troop 648 in Brunswick, is working to earn his Eagle Scout Award. He presented his Eagle Scout project to the parish finance council in March and with a unanimous vote, the project was approved. Joe has already submitted the required paperwork to his council and his next step is to raise the needed funds for the project. He has estimated his cost to be \$8,000- \$10,000, depending on the type of carpet we choose to install. This would cover the cost of materials and labor for the project. Joseph will be presenting his plan to all parish churches over the next few months before and after Masses. 
